If the status is "FULL", the clinic is at maximum seating capacity and can take no further reservations.

Entry Grade 8 clinics are 8 hour clinics recommended for those 13 and older, however no minimum age requirement. This clinic provides a black badge, and allows officiating youth and adult amateur matches. The written test is a 50 question test written to the 9th School grade reading level.

Remember:

- 1) You will have online videos to watch in preparation for this clinic. Once you have successfully registered for the class, your online videos can be accessed from your account in wareferees.org.
- 2) This class consists of both classroom and outdoor instruction on a field at the complex.
 1. Bring paper and pencil for notes.
 2. Bring lunch and any drinks you may want. Lunch time is approximate and there will not be an opportunity to leave and get lunch.
 3. Bring shoes appropriate for light work on the soccer field (cleats not required but recommended). And dress for the weather.
 4. Bring your referee whistle, referee flags, and red/yellow cards.
- 3) There will be an exam at the end of class which **MUST** be passed to earn your license. Pay very close attention to the questions and answers during the online education.
