# **RULES FOR SYNTHETIC TURF FIELD USE**

To prolong the life span of the field, please observe the following rules:



They are permitted on any natural grass area.



#### NO FOOD, GUM, SEEDS OR TOBACCO PRODUCTS

Suntan lotions, oils, athletic creams or any other substance that can stain are also prohibited.





#### VEHICLES OF ANY KIND ARE PROHIBITED

Includes but not limited to automobiles, bicycles, scooters, skateboards, RC cars, planes, drones, or other toys that use fuel.



# NO METAL CLEATS

Athletic cleats must be rubber & less than 2 inches. Footwear should also be clean & free of mud.



SHARP OR NARROW LEGS Tables, chairs, & benches with

a sled base are permitted. No flags, shade structures, tents, stakes & umbrellas.

WHEN TRANSPORTING EQUIPMENT: All equipment must be carried across the field or have turf wheels. MUNICIPAL CODE: 11.04.010 and 11.04.100

# USER GROUP RESPONSIBILITIES FOR SYNTHETIC TURF USE

## CLEANLINESS

- Leave the field cleaner than you found it and ready for the next park user
- Inspect the field and remove trash and debris left by your players or spectators after practices and games

### SPILLS AND DAMAGES

- Remove any foreign substances, including bodily fluids, as quickly as possible using the provided cleaning solution
- Thoroughly rinse and avoid slippery areas that could result in injury
- Immediately report the location of the accident or injury resulting in bodily fluids (blood, vomit, urine, etc.) on the turf to Park Patrol

### DAMAGES

- Inspect your playing area before and after practices and games
- Report any areas of the playing surface area that are damaged or deficient to Park Patrol

# EDUCATE

 Inform your players, parents and spectators about synthetic turf rules to minimize damages to the playing surface
