

Adult Softball Return to Play Guidelines



1. Current State and Department of Health Requirements:

- 1. Each field will be limited to a **maximum of 150 people** which includes staff, umpires, players, coaches and spectators. This guideline will be strictly enforced.
- 2. All staff, umpires, coaches and spectators are required to wear a face covering at all times while on PVSC property including: the fields, dugouts, bleachers, grass areas, playground, etc.
- 3. Players are allowed to remove face coverings during games and in the field of play only. Face coverings must be worn by players when training/practicing or when not actively competing in a game against another team including in the dugout. As soon as a player steps off the field of play, they should immediately put on a face covering.
- 3. Everyone should social distance by a minimum of 6 feet when possible.

2. Game Modifications:

- Teams won't be permitted to enter the facility more than 20 minutes prior to their game time.
- Teams won't be able to enter the field area including dugouts until the teams from the previous game has completely left.
- Upon arrival and departure, coach/team rep is responsible for ensuring:
 - 1. All players & coaches wash/sanitize their hands.
 - 2. Benches should be sanitized.
 - 3. All trash is picked up.
- Players should quickly gather their belongings and exit the dugout at the conclusion of the game.

3. Miscellaneous:

- No sunflower seeds, gum and spitting are allowed anywhere on the PVSC property.
- Players not allowed to go to their mouth to improve grip on the ball.
- All players are required to provide their own clearly marked water/sporting drink bottle.
- All teams/players must turn in a new Covid waiver with signatures before they can play in any City of Puyallup league.

Please help staff ensure that all players and fans are following these guidelines or we may be required to shut down.

Anyone not following these Department of Health guidelines will be asked to leave.
