FILLING OUT IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Make sure the front of your card is completely filled out

-Date -Diamond -League -Visiting Team name -Home Team name -Umpire(s) signature(s) -Starting Time -Final Scores

Make sure the interior of your card is completely filled out

-Team names -Names of ALL players -Mangers signatures -Final Scores

KEEPING SCORE

Numbered columns indicate innings please make sure you are scoring in the correct column

-Use the scoring symbols above to record plays as they happen during each inning.

-Make sure to record the score in the correct row (indicated by the player's name)

-At the end of each inning total the number of runs and hits

-At the end of the game add up the number of runs, this is the final score (the final score *MUST* be equal to the total number of filled diamonds, used to keep score, a team has)

Example



A box filled out like this indicates:

- The player hit the ball and made it to 1st base

-Then subsequent player(s) hit the ball and this player was able to make it around the bases and score a run

AT THE END OF THE GAME BOTH MANAGERS NEED TO SIGN THE SCORECARD *The winning team is responsible for turning in the score card*
