Referee Job Description

Pre-season:

1. Help line fields with other referees, supervisors, TYSA board members
2. Attend pre-season meeting

Games:

1. Arrive 15 minutes before first game.
2. Check field, check nets/goals
3. Check appropriate attire for players: shin guards, no jewelry
4. Make calls –
 - a. Blow the whistle
 - b. Communicate loudly & clearly so coaches and other referee can understand the call
 - c. Please make calls – When calls are not made, it increases the chance of escalation of out of control behavior
5. Procedure with Problem Coaches or Parents
 - a. First, Ask them politely to calm down, respect others...
 - b. If they continue, Inform them they will be asked to leave
 - c. If they still continue, Ask them to leave
 - d. If they do not, get one of the Board Members

League Differences:

1. Beginner league
 - a. Help teach soccer skills for first 30 minutes
 - i. Dribbling, passing, etc.
2. Midget league
 - a. No offside penalty
 - b. No heading
 - c. Bad throw-ins – rethrow until correct
3. Bantam
 - a. Offside penalty
 - i. (no offsides on a throw-in or corner kick)
 - b. No heading
 - c. Bad-throw-ins – automatic turnover
 - d. Goalie – 6 seconds
4. Knee Hi
 - a. Offside penalty
 - b. Heading is permitted
 - c. Bad-throw-ins – automatic turnover
 - d. Goalie – 6 seconds
