All teams will be responsible for paying \$12 CASH to the umpire before the start of each game. Failure to pay the umpire will result in a forfeit.

Leagues Offered:

All teams will play a 6-game season and a single elimination tournament. Teams select to play in the Competitive or Recreation Division. Leagues will not be mixed until tournament play when brackets are arranged according to competition levels. There must be a minimum of 4 teams in each league for play to be scheduled.

Competitive:

- Competitive teams with experience playing in the league. They play to win.

Recreation:

- Work teams or teams with players who are looking to have fun first and win second.

Registration and Fees (per team):

- **Registration:** June 17th – July 21st (in person or online)

All teams: **\$242.00** (\$225 league fee + tax) *

**Due to bill LB 727 all adult recreation is taxed at 7.25% sales tax.*

Season Dates:

- The season begins Sunday, August 4th and runs for 7 weeks, without games being played on Labor Day weekend.
- Tournament play begins the week following the conclusion of regular season play.
- All rain-out days will be made up prior to the start of the tournament if time permits.

General Information:

- **TEAM FORMAT:** *Mixed coed - a minimum of 2 of one sex is required to play in the field and at least 2 of that sex in the lineup to kick.*
- Teams are 10 vs 10 with a maximum of 14 playing / kicking per team.
- Teams may move divisions come tournament time to better the competition.
- Teams need to provide their own size 4 soccer ball. Teams kick the ball they bring.
- All games will be played at the Lewis ballfield complex.
- Umpires and supervisors will be provided by the Team Sports Office.
- Games could be cancelled due to weather conditions; we suggest that all teams/players sign up for text alert notification via www.teamsideline.com/lincolnne
