# ***OmegaBall 2024***

***All teams will be responsible for paying \$8 CASH to the umpire before the start of each game. Failure to pay the umpire will result in a forfeit.***

*OmegaBall is a growing sport that has its foundation in soccer (or its international name, football), but is a faster paced game with more action and scoring. OmegaBall is a team game played with one size 5 soccer ball, three (3) teams, three (3) goals, three (3) "Dead Ball" (corner kick) locations, one center spot, 3 penalty arcs (36' arcs) and five (5) players per team. There are no "throw-ins" and no offsides rule.*

## **League Offered:**

All teams will play a 6-game regular season and a single elimination tournament on Wednesday evenings at Elks Field (Normal Blvd. & Sumner St.).

## **Registration and Fees (per team):**

- Registration: June 17<sup>th</sup> – July 21<sup>st</sup> (in person or online)
- All teams: \$242.00 (\$225 league fee + tax) \*

*\*Due to bill LB 727 all adult recreation is taxed at 7.25% sales tax.*

## **Season Dates:**

- The season begins Wednesday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Tournament play begins the week following the conclusion of regular season play.
- All rain-out days will be made up prior to the start of the tournament if time permits.

## **General Information:**

- **TEAM FORMAT:** COED – no minimum of either gender.
- Games are 5 v 5 v 5.
- Teams may be placed in separate divisions prior to tournament play to better the competition.
- Teams should have their own jerseys, but pinnies will be available for use.
- Umpires and supervisors will be provided by the Team Sports Office.
