Introduction

All ballfield reservations are conducted out of the Team Sports Office. It has become necessary to publish this manual due to the large number of users requesting fields. This manual dictates the fees and procedures used for Lincoln Parks and Recreation fields. Failure to follow the policies listed in this manual will result in the loss of privilege to use any fields.

Throughout the past 45+ years, the City of Lincoln has developed some of its park land into competition quality ballfields. This manual addresses the competition fields considered gold level as well as some fields considered silver or bronze level. Silver and bronze level fields lack lights, irrigation, fencing, etc.

Priority order of users of the city fields:

- #1 City sponsored softball leagues and events
- #2 Lincoln Public Schools
- #3 Legion Baseball
- #4 Jr. Saltdogs & Babe Ruth Youth Baseball
- #5 Other Schools
- #6 Adult and youth softball and baseball organizations
- #7 Non-profit clubs, teams, and organizations
- #8 All other organizations

It is the commitment of the Team Sports staff to accommodate as many organizations as possible. Organizations will be asked to fit their activity into the best accommodating facilities.

The City of Lincoln has several Reciprocal Use Agreements with certain organizations to facilitate programs. These Agreements must be accommodated first, as well as honoring tournaments and activities that have developed a historical standing.



The Lincoln Parks and Recreation Department conducts all rental activity uniformly and consistently. Organizations must follow all guidelines and procedures for field use to retain the privilege of using City ballfields. Rentals require an Athletic Field Use Request, and possibly other forms based on type of use.

Teams who participated in the Draft will be able to view the Matrix online at www.teamsideline.com/lincolnne. If changes to drafted fields are necessary, please contact the Team Sports Office.

Teams are not permitted to use a field when not scheduled for their use.

Field times not taken by draft teams, will be opened to the public to reserve online. If Drafted teams need additional field time outside of their 2-hour block, online reservations must be made.

Example: If a draft team plans to play a game during their 6-8pm time block, the coach needs to make the online reservation for the field from 5-6pm if they wish to warmup/set up in order to begin the game at 6pm. This 5pm time could get reserved by another party for practice!!!

Field use will become available on March 9, 2026, or shortly thereafter depending on field conditions.

Park Hours:

City ordinance 12.08.070 (b) <u>Subject to the provisions of this section</u>, all parks shall be open daily to the public <u>during the hours of 5:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.</u> Lights <u>MUST</u> be turned off, and the park cleared by 11 PM
