

## **Ballfield User Expectations**

Ч	Please be respectful of other reservations. Your field use is for a specific time; do
	not infringe on other's reservations.
	If the base peg markers (whiskers) are any color other than orange, the base peg
	is located ~6" closer to home plate than that whisker. DO NOT dig up those
	markers/whiskers. Please return the orange base peg caps after using bases, if
	you have access.
	Do not take bases from one field/site to another.
	Field lights should not be turned ON more than 45 minutes prior to sunset. Refer
	to the Ballfield Manual for location of light switches.
	When performing field maintenance, do not dig trenches or drag with
	unauthorized motor vehicles (tractors, 4-wheelers, etc.).
	Keep storage areas locked and organized when not in use. Don't leave your key in
	a padlock or the padlock in an open position when using a field.
	Throw away empty chalk bags. Do not leave empty bags in the storage area.
	Per Section 12.08.270 of Lincoln Municipal Code, it shall be unlawful for any
	person to consume or possess any alcoholic liquor in any park or park facility;
	provided, however, the above prohibition shall not apply to properly licensed or
	permitted according to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
	<b>Lightning / Severe Weather Action Plan</b> - If lightning is identified as striking
	within a 10- mile radius via any weather app., athletic field use must be
	suspended, and the complex vacated. Patrons should be instructed to wait in
	their vehicles. Thunder can usually be heard at 10 miles and be used as an
	accurate signal to end play. Play should not resume until 30 min. after the last
	lightning was visible, or thunder was heard.
	Make sure all equipment and bases are picked up, the lights are turned OFF, and
	the storage area is locked before leaving the field.
