

Frequently Asked Questions

1 I don't have a partner, what Plea can I do?

2 Will there be any mixed doubles?

No, this event is for same-gender doubles teams only.

3 How do I determine my NTRP skill level?

4 What if my partner and I are at different levels?

You will be placed in the bracket of the higher-level player. For example, if you are an A-level player and your partner is a B-level player, your team will compete in the A bracket. (League levels will be verified.)

5 Can I change my partner on the day of the tournament?

Yes, but your new partner must complete a waiver form and submit payment before participating.

6	What is the last day a refund will be issued?	Refunds will be issued through Friday, October 11. No refunds will be given after this date.
7	What do I need to bring?	We recommend bringing a chair, plenty of drinks, snacks, and anything else that will help keep you comfortable and happy throughout the day.
8	How many matches will my partner and I play?	You'll be placed in a pod with 3–4 other doubles teams and will compete in a round-robin format. If you win your pod, you'll advance to the next round. Most teams will play a minimum of 3 matches and a maximum of 5–6, depending on the number of entries in your bracket.
