

Central Virginia United Soccer Complex Usage Rules and Expectations



Central Virginia United Soccer Club is pleased to partner with Campbell County Parks & Recreation for field usage at the CVU Soccer Complex this spring. In order to maintain the quality of our facilities and ensure a safe, family-friendly environment for all participants and visitors, the following rules must be followed at all times by all coaches, players, families, and spectators associated with Campbell County Parks & Recreation.

These rules apply to the entire CVU Soccer Complex, including parking areas, roadways, fields, pavilion areas, and all gated spaces.

1. Speed Limit and Traffic Safety

The speed limit throughout the CVU Soccer Complex is 8 miles per hour. This applies to all vehicles at all times, including during practices, games, and events.

The complex is heavily used by children and families, and players frequently walk between fields and parking areas. Drivers must operate vehicles carefully and yield to pedestrians at all times.

Speeding, reckless driving, or unsafe vehicle operation will not be tolerated.

2. No Smoking Policy

The CVU Soccer Complex is a 100% smoke-free facility.

Smoking and vaping are strictly prohibited anywhere on CVU property, including:

- Parking lots
- Roadways
- Fields and sidelines
- Pavilion areas
- Near buildings or entrances

This policy is in place to maintain a healthy environment for youth athletes and families.

3. No Dogs or Pets

Dogs and pets are not permitted anywhere within the CVU Soccer Complex.

This includes:

- Parking areas
- Spectator areas
- Sidelines
- Fields
- Pavilion areas

The only exception is for certified service animals.

4. Field and Facility Care

To protect the playing surfaces and facilities:

- No vehicles are permitted inside gated field areas
- Goals may not be moved without permission
- No stakes, tents, or field markings without prior approval
- All trash must be picked up and placed in trash cans
- Teams must leave the fields and sidelines clean after use
- No glass containers are allowed anywhere on the complex

5. Parking

All vehicles must park in designated parking areas only. Do not park along roadways, near field entrances, or in grass areas unless directed.

6. Sideline and Spectator Conduct

All players, coaches, and spectators are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and sportsmanlike manner at all times. This includes:

- Respect for referees, coaches, players, and spectators
- No abusive language
- No fighting or aggressive behavior
- No alcohol permitted on the property

7. Enforcement and Violations

Campbell County Parks & Recreation is responsible for communicating these rules to all coaches, players, and families using the CVU Soccer Complex.

Failure to follow CVU Complex rules – including speeding, smoking, or bringing dogs to the complex – will result in the immediate revocation of field usage privileges for Campbell County Parks & Recreation for the remainder of the season.

These rules are in place to protect the facility, ensure safety, and maintain a positive environment for all organizations that use the complex.
