Points of Emphasis for Cary Youth League Basketball Games:

- 1) T-Shirts If worn, should match the jersey color. However, this is not required. If the t-shirt does not match and is nowhere close to the correct color, the player should be permitted to play, and Town staff should note the discrepancy for league manager to follow up on.
- 2) Prewrap, headbands, compression sleeves and such NO NCHSAA Application Differences in colors allowed local rule
- 3) Strings on shorts tucked in
- 4) Safety items like casts, jewelry, hair clips NCHSAA application from the start of the season.
- 5) NCHSAA Sportsmanship Interpretation for foul language 2 Techs to coach = DQ
- 6) Coaching area in effect Coaches should not be in the way of the scorer's table, on the court and such. They should remain in their coaching area.
- 7) Language Zero tolerance on bad language from start of season
- 8) Teams ahead by 15-points may not backcourt press, and must retreat to the other half of the court until the lead drops below 15
- 9) 40-point difference for running clock in effect: Once the score reaches a 40 point differential after halftime, the clock runs continuously, only stopping on timeouts and substitution breaks
- 10) Official should treat mid-quarter substitutions as full, 1-minute timeouts, and should be treated as a team timeout. Officials are to stop play for the mid quarter subs with whistles; staff at table should not have to sound horn. All subs must check in at the table. If they are subbing fewer than 5 players the players staying in the game have to go to the table and check in.
- 11) All timeouts are 60-second timeouts. Table staff and officials should work together to ensure the first horn/whistle does not come before 45 seconds, unless both teams are on the court ready for play. The second horn/whistle should come at 60 seconds.
- 12) Time Outs team receive 3 time out per game. Teams are allowed 1 time out per overtime period (time outs do not carry over).
- 13) U10 Girls, U12 Girls and U10 Boys Free throws are made from a 12ft line. Players in the lane are to use the normal positions as if they are shooting from the 15ft line. Be aware that players in the lane are not allowed to violate the free throw shooters area behind the free throw line, nor make contact with them PRIOR to the ball hitting the rim. They are allowed to enter the lane on release but it has to be in front of the free throw line.
- 14) U10 Girls & U10 Boys- No stealing off the dribble after a 15 point lead is established. (Stealing can resume if lead drops to 5 or less)
- 15) Foul reporting Use proper mechanics and rotation of positions to ensure the fouls are reported properly
