



Zeeland Little League All-Star Player Commitment Form

Completion of this form indicates that your child wants to be considered for the 2024 Zeeland Little League All-Star team. This is not a registration form, as All-Star teams are selected through a different process. It is an honor to be selected, and all players and parents who choose to participate must understand and meet specific commitments that are required.

1. Proof of age and residency

In lieu of providing documents to prove residency, parents/guardians may elect to complete the “[School Enrollment Form](#)” which is available on the Zeeland Little League website. This form must be completed in combination with an appropriate school administrator (principal, headmaster, etc.) and returned to Zeeland Little League.

If selected to the All-Star tournament team, parents/guardians must produce an original government issued birth certificate or an original Little League “In lieu of Birth Certificate” document within 7 days after notification of placement on the team roster. Originals must be shown and copies will need to be provided within 7 days after notification of placement on the team roster.

In accordance with Little League rules, parents/guardians of the player must also provide documentation to determine and verify proof of residency or school enrollment. For proof of residency, documents must contain parent(s) or court-appointed guardian(s) name, street address, city, state, and zip code information, dated or in force between February 1 of the previous year and February 1 of the current year, from EACH of the three groups outlined below:

2. Player Eligibility During Regular Season

To be eligible to be selected onto the All-Star team, a player must play in at least 60% of regular season games. The only excused absences are an injury or sickness provided with a doctor's note or playing for the team where the child attends school. If a player misses a game with an excused absence, he/she must still meet the 60% attendance requirement, however the missed game will not count towards the total games played.

(For instance, if a player only attended 7 of the 12 regular season games, the attendance record would be 58% and that player would not be eligible for All-Stars. However, if that same player had one excused absence, the new attendance record would be 7 out of 11 games which is 64% and that player would be eligible for All-Stars)

3. All-Start Tryout Attendance

To be eligible to be selected onto the All-Star team, a player must attend the All-Star tryout. If a player is unable to attend, an excused absence must be granted by either the ZLL President or Vice President for the player to remain eligible. An unexcused absence will deem the player ineligible for the All-Star team. The ZLL Board may also determine that a tryout is not necessary for certain All-Star teams, and the team will be formed via the All-Star Team Selection process located in the All Star Policy without a tryout.

4. Player Availability & Attendance for All-Star Team

To be eligible to be selected onto the All-Star team, a player must be available for all practices and games for the All-Star team. Practices begin after teams are announced (no earlier than June 1st). Expect that there will be additional practices and/or a parent meeting after All-Star players are announced, including Saturdays. You should expect practices to continue through the regular season and through D9 Tournament play. Practices are scheduled by the All Star Coaches. Games and practices will continue throughout the All-Star Tournament until the team is eliminated. If there is more than one (1) unexcused absence from a game or practice, the player may be removed from the team. An excused absence would be a medical or family emergency. If regular season games or the D9 Tournament are still active, the player's regular season team practices and games are considered excused absences from All-Star activities. All other absences are unexcused, unless excused by the Manager.



5. Tournament Dates and Locations

The 11-year-old (11 and 10 year olds) and 10-year-old teams (10, 9 and 8 year olds) are eligible to advance as far as the State Tournament by winning the District 9 Championship. The 12U teams are eligible to advance beyond the State Tournament and as far as the Little League World Series. Schedules are as follows (subject to change):

6. All-Star Tournament Mandatory Play Rules

Every player on the team roster and present at the game shall be in the batting line-up (Rocket Batting Rules). The All-Star Manager will be allowed to manage playing time in the field and utilize his/her roster as he/she sees fit so long as the Little League Tournament Rules are followed. All teams will have rosters at a minimum of 12 and maximum of 15 players.

7. Parent or Guardian Responsibilities

Parents and players are responsible for a portion of the expenses incurred when selected to the All-Star Team. Each player must pay \$80 to help cover the cost for All-Star activities, including a jersey which players keep. Cost is not be a preventative factor for any player to participate. Therefore, if a player needs assistance, they simply need to approach the Zeeland Little League President with their request. This will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

Parents (and their guests) are responsible for their attitudes and behavior toward volunteer coaches, players, spectators and the umpires. Unruly and disruptive parents are the single greatest contributor to a negative All-Star experience for volunteer coaches, players and other parents. ZLL expects parents to be supportive and encouraging throughout the All-Star season and during all practices & games. Many players experience their first brushes with significantly better competition, failure, or sitting on a bench. These challenges can occur throughout the All-Star season and they require parents, coaches and teammates to work together to provide a supportive and encouraging environment.
