Team Formation

- Slowly eliminated drafts and had ZLL put together teams
- Draft Issues
 - Focus on making the "best" team when the goal is to have them all equal
 - Bias and manipulation of scores during TFP
 - Experienced coaches had advantage over new coaches
 - Coaches draft players earlier than needed to make sure a family member or friend was on team

Team Formation

- For 2025 Season, ZLL plans to put together all teams
- Team Formation Practice information still essential in this
- Fewer coach evaluators needed coaches can evaluate OR help run drills
 - Would prefer ZLL Members be freed up to do evaluating
- Process for requesting a player for your team will be sent in later email
 - Request is for friends and family, NOT the best player in the league
 - Depending on situation, there is a chance request can't be granted

Team Formation Practice

- Come at your Division time(s)
 - Feel free to help any other divisions you want
- Get evaluation sheet if you want to score players
- Coaches that want to help run drills will be split at stations
- Each player will get a hitting and fielding score
- Players that pitch will get a pitcher score
- Evaluations used for final division placement and teams

Team Formation Practice

- Players get a bib number as they check in
- Roll Call (much quicker this year)
- Break kids into groups
- Groups on field, cages, and/or bullpen
 - Field does fielding and then pitching
- Groups rotate through each station

- Email is sent once roster is uploaded into site
 - I will also email coaches to let you know
- Next step, EMAIL YOUR TEAM
 - I will send a "template email" for you to fill in blanks
- Give them your contact info and preferred contact method
- Verify family contact info
- Ask to give you a heads up on dates they know they will miss
- Set up a snack/drink sign up (or assign a "team parent")

Equipment

Let's talk about baseballs at Kaat

- Each team will get a bucket of practice balls
- Used game balls should be split between teams and added to practice bucket after games
- Fields will have less practice balls available

Equipment

- Equipment pickup will be week of March 17
- Each team gets an equipment bag
 - Catchers gear and helmets
- If you need different sizes, switch out gear from shed or let me know
- Bats, tees, screens, fielder masks stay in shed/locker
- Shed combos TBD
- Game Balls will come from UMPS
 - They are in the shed, but please let umps bring out

Uniforms

- Uniform pickup will be at Zeeland Rec in early April
 - Will send email when ready (4/14)
- I will email coaches a roster with sizes
- Names on Shirts?
 - ZLL cannot afford to put names on shirts
 - Multiple companies can do it, just reach out
 - Usually about \$5 per shirt



Rules

Equal Playing Time

The information below does NOT pertain to the position of <u>pitcher</u>. More information on pitchers is in the next section.

- All players are in the lineup and hit in every game
- The lineup should be different each game such that players are in a different spots in the lineup throughout the season
 - Coach Pitch and Tee Ball teams change their lineup each inning
- Each player must play a minimum of one inning in an infield position each game
- All players should be on the bench for an inning before any player is on the bench for a second inning
 - The exception to this rule is for a player that is pitching multiple innings, he/she must spend an inning on the bench when done pitching if every other player on the team has already spent an inning on the bench
- Zeeland Little League provides templates for coaches to pre-plan their lineups and field positions for each game in order to fulfill these requirements

Rules

Pitchers and Equal Playing Time

The pitcher is an important position in Little League. The pitcher controls the pace and action of a game. An inexperienced pitcher that is unable to throw strikes can cause a detriment to all players in the game. Although walks are part of the game, excessive walks can lessen the experience for everyone.

- All pitchers must abide by the pitch count rules set forth by Little League
- The amount of innings pitched through a season will NOT be equal amongst every player on the team that wants to pitch
- Coaches may, and are encouraged to, give more pitching opportunities to players that show more consistency in throwing strikes
- If a pitcher is struggling to throw strikes, coaches may replace the pitcher at their own discretion.
 - We recommend coaches make a change at pitcher after 4 walks in an inning especially for an inexperienced pitcher
- Pitchers that perform better in games will pitch more often than pitchers who are less consistent.

Experience in pitching in games is important for player development, but it cannot be the only time a player that wants to pitch is working on pitching. Players are encouraged to work on pitching at practice and at home.

Weather Policy

- TRY to make decisions by 5:00PM
- Final decision will come from either Brett, Mandee, or Brandon via email and app
- If something comes up mid-game = DELAY
 - Be smart and use your best judgement
 - Mid-Practice = you can delay or cancel
 - If you get message from us to cancel, SHUT IT DOWN!
- There is such a thing as too hot
- Weather policy emailed out before practices start

Extra Coaches

- OK to ask parents to help at practice and games as long as ZLL Coach is present
- If someone else wants to help be a COACH, they must sign up on the coaching form
- Should never have a situation that someone is running a practice or game and NOT a signed up ZLL Coach

Scheduling

- Kaat practice schedule rotates between fields
- A and AA Quincy is being used as a practice field
 - Quincy also has some openings for extra practice
- Softball Interleague with Holland
- Softball working on getting Club schedule
 - Can use DeWitt fields when club isn't on them for moving things around

Practices

- Practices are built into schedule
- Start March 24
 - Spring Break week scheduled but cancel if needed
- Practice blocks are 90 minutes
 - A-Baseball first practices are 60
- Practice may be scheduled with another team
 - If location is field team starts on field for 45 minutes
 - If location is CAGE team starts in cage for 45 minutes
 - Switch halfway
 - Talk with other coaches and adjust if you want
 - Option Mix in a scrimmage

Practice Plans

- Know what you are doing before you show up
- Break into groups and stations more reps and less waiting
- Add something FUN
- Coaches Tab on the website = RESOURCE
- Weekly emails for practices from ZLL

Practice Recommendations

- First practices keep it light and get to know the players
- Light pitching work
- Incentives and competitions
 - keep kids engaged
- Less talk, more action



Adding Practices

- You can schedule additional Practices
 - We may cancel your practice in order to schedule a makeup game
- Start with your "Home Fields"
- If nothing available, contact me and I can give you options
- Saturday afternoons are almost always open

Games

- Majors April 19
- All others Week of April 21
 - As we make schedule, April 19 may be used for some games besides just Majors (AAA, AA, and Minors)

Game Planning

- Plan out the lineups and positions for game ZLL SITE
 - POST IT
 - Adjust as necessary based on pitcher
- Pitchers should NOT be going max pitch count in 1st half
 - BASEBALL Keep Pitch Count

Game Planning

- What is equal playing time?
- Pitcher ≠ Position Player time
- Hold yourself and each other accountable

Field Management (Kaat and Huizenga)

- Extra gear in sheds and dugout containers
- Home team does scoreboard during game
- Put away controller after game
- Field cleanup procedures will be emailed and posted

Subs

- Short on players? Get a sub
 - You can play a game with 8 (we do NOT want forfeits)
 - Sub cannot pitch and can only catch if approved by ZLL
- View Sub List under TEAMS tab on website
- Find a player in an equal or lower division not playing
- Start at top of list and work down!
- Reach out if you need help.
- REPORT SUBS to Brandon
 - That way we can move player to bottom of list

Umpires

- RESPECT
- They are going to make mistakes
- Help where you can
- Challenging calls is unnecessary...
- Asking for clarification is OK in between innings
- If issue arises, tell us

Umpires

- If no-show...
 - Check for POOL UMP
 - Check other fields...if they have 2 get 1 for you
 - Call Brandon
- If we know you will have 1 or 0 ump before game, we will let you know
- You can also see who is umpiring on the schedule!
- Please report any umpire no-show

Kaat Day and Gentex Games

- For all divisions present
- Players vote for teammates to represent their team
 - I will email a voting form in May with a deadline
- Teams are formed like a traditional MLB All Star Game
- Games are scheduled in early June (day/time TBD)
- Allowing coaches to use more discretion for last pick

Post Season Games

- Single-A Baseball no "postseason" but last game at Kaat
- AA and AAA Baseball Tournament with 2 games guaranteed
- Majors Baseball Tournament with Holland LL
- Minors and Majors Softball Tournament with Holland LL

- All coaches invited (encouraged) to attend and evaluate
- Use what you saw during season and at tryout to rank players
- Rankings are put together and create All-Star team
