Travel Tales

Welcome to travel soccer! All travel teams, except those players entering 8th grade, will have new kits this year. We will wear the Gold jersey for all home games and Purple for all away games. However, please bring both jerseys to every game, just in case.

We will use TeamSnap for all communication. It is very important that you mark your child's availability for both games and practices so that coaches can be prepared for both. The sooner you mark availability, the better. This is especially true for the Ohio Travel Cup tournament in October.

There are a lot of days to keep in mind for travel:

August 12: Schedules are released by OHTSL

August 18: Start of Travel Season

October 5-6: Ohio Travel Cup. All travel teams will be registered for this tournament

October 20: Last official day of travel season

The week of August 12 all travel teams will have a practice at Heasley Fields. Your coaches will mark the practice in TeamSnap. This will also be the time that players will get their new kits. We like to have teams practice at Heasley so that coaches can go over field positions and show the new players which lines they need to know.

A friendly reminder: Players should come to each practice wearing a purple shirt, shin quards and cleats.
