Concord Adult Softball Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How can an individual player get on a team?

A: Go to **www.teamsideline.com/concord** to add yourself to the **Free Agent List**, or call (925) 671-3423. This list of interested players is kept current and made available to all team managers who are looking for players. The list provides basic contact information including league preference and player experience. Please note that this is a referral service only and does not guarantee individual placements.

Q: How do I get a copy of the Free Agent List?

A: The list is available to current Concord League managers to pick up at the Sports Office, Willow Pass Community Center, or by emailing a request to sports@cityofconcord.org.

Q: Can I play on more than one team?

A: A player may participate on more than one team. Certain restrictions do apply. Refer to the Concord Softball League Rules for the complete details on these restrictions.

Q: How late can players be added to our roster?

A: Roster additions will be allowed until the start of the 6th game of the Spring season.

Q: Where can I get information on approved bats?

A: Concord Adult Softball uses the Licensed/Approved Bats list distributed by USSSA. The most current information on approved bats can be found on their website. All bats used in Concord Adult Softball must be USSSA-approved.

Q: How often are standings updated?

A: Every effort is made to update standings at least once a week. The most current standings are listed at www.teamsideline.com/concord.

Q: When will make-up games be played?

A: All teams must be prepared to play make-up games any day of the week, including Saturdays and Sundays. Make-up games not completed prior to the end of the season will be scheduled for **Saturday, May 10.**

Q: What is the playoff format?

A: Playoffs begin May 12 (approx.) for qualifying teams. Spring softball leagues play a traditional style, single elimination playoff tournament. Playoffs are comprised of teams from all nights of play; therefore, **Teams will play on nights** other than their regular night of play during playoffs.

Q: Where can I get a copy of the rules?

A: Concord Softball League Rules are available at the Sports Office, Willow Pass Community Center, or at www.teamsideline.com/concord.
