Registration fees cover less than 35% of the actual cost to run a full season of Little League Baseball Our desire is to allow as many children to participate as possible. As a non-profit organization, we rely heavily on volunteers in a variety of ways to run a successful league.

We offer many opportunities to volunteer, some are listed below:

In the past, it has been difficult for the league to find enough volunteers. As such, we will require each family to work 10 hours per child, for the first two children in the family. Please note the following requirements:

Majors, AAA, AA, A, and Tball Divisions*- 10 hour requirement <u>must include at least one assigned</u> <u>shift in the snack bar</u>. In the event that your assigned date is cancelled, you will be reassigned.

*Please note that Managers, Coaches, Team Parents, and Scorekeepers will be contacted to work in the event there is no commitment from your team to work their assigned shift.

To ensure that each player fulfills their volunteer commitment, we require a \$150 deposit (either by providing a personal check, money order or cashiers check) per player. The checks will only be cashed by the league if the volunteer commitment has not been fulfilled. At the conclusion of the season, the uncashed check will be returned to you or destroyed by the league. It is a much greater benefit for the league, and your children, to give your time, rather than your money.
