PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Mt. Prospect Patriots is a travel baseball program run through the Mt. Prospect Park District and is an extension of the Mt. Prospect Park District House Baseball League. If your player is looking to continue playing baseball at an advanced level beyond house league, then this may be the path for you.

WHY CHOOSE THE PATRIOTS?

Our program is one of the most affordable travel baseball programs in the area, for the amount of features each player gets for their fee. Our coaches are volunteers but are required to complete High School level Baseball training. Our teams play against appropriate competition that allows our players to succeed and develop. "THE PATRIOTS WAY" (MISSION STATEMENT)

We strive to provide the best experience, team culture & development for our players. Patriots players & families are expected to show good sportsmanship & respect towards opponents, officials/umpires and any other involved parties throughout the season. Players should have a positive attitude and be prepared to improve their skills. It is our goal to develop players into the best they can be.

HOW PLAYERS ARE CHOSEN AND CRITERIA USED IN FORMING TEAMS:

- Players between the ages of 8-14 years must attend a tryout in order to be eligible to be selected for the Patriots.
- Tryout dates, times and locations will be communicated to all MPPD house league players and
 their parents via emails and placed on the <u>Patriots Baseball Team Sideline website</u>. Extenuating
 circumstances, such as injury or illness during the tryout period, must be communicated to the
 Mt. Prospect Park District so that a player can be evaluated at some other time, *if possible*.
- Trying out does not mean that a player is automatically selected for a travel team. The philosophy of travel play is to field the most competitive team possible.
- Tryouts at each age level will be conducted by third party evaluators, who do not have a child trying out for a team.
- The following areas will be evaluated during tryouts:
 - 1. Infield abilities (arm strength, range, throwing accuracy)
 - 2. Outfield abilities (catching, arm strength)
 - 3. Baserunning (speed, consistency, hustle)
 - 4. Hitting (form, hand/eye coordination, power/contact)
 - 5. (optional) Pitching (velocity, command)
 - 6. Attitude and effort during the tryout.
 - 7. Commitment to the team (ie attendance for games & practices) could also be a factor in determining who makes the team.
- The number of players chosen for a team and the number of teams at each age level will be determined on the skill level of those trying out annually.

• Players who are trying out should try out for their appropriate age level. In certain circumstances, a player may be invited to participate for the next highest age level team. If this occurs, there is no guarantee to be selected on the same team for the following season.

DEVELOPMENTAL PHILOSOPHY FOR PATRIOTS TEAMS

- 8U/9U Primarily development, multiple positions, some strategy
- 10U Advanced development, still play several positions, baseball strategy
- 11U Full baseball rules, building baseball IQ, 2-3 positions, advanced baseball strategy
- 12U Strategy nuances, advanced baseball IQ, 1-2 positions, advanced baseball strategy
- 13U Intro to advanced baseball IQ, 1-2 positions
- 14U Advanced baseball IQ, 1-2 positions

HOW COACHES ARE CHOSEN AND CRITERIA USED:

- Managers and Assistant Coaches will be determined after evaluations are completed. Anyone
 interested in managing/coaching should not assume their child(ren) are guaranteed placement
 on a Patriot team; child(ren) of coaches must have the ability to be selected for a team
 independent of whether or not their parent has shown interest in coaching.
- All Managers and Coaches must complete all required MPPD volunteer forms and are subject to a background check to be considered. Anyone interested in coaching a Patriots team should contact the <u>Athletic Manager</u> prior to the tryout date(s).

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When are Tryouts:	Tryouts will be held in July/August for the upcoming year. Specific Dates, Times &			
	Locations for each age group will be determined at a later date. Families will be asked			
	to give a verbal commitment within 48 hours of teams being posted.			
Time Commitment:	The Patriots travel teams play at a "B/C" level of competition (the next level after house			
	league) and require a strong commitment from both player and family. Your spring/summer through the end of July will consist of many trips to Mt. Prospect fields			
	and surrounding suburbs with a lot of baseball (practices and games). Mt. Prospect Park			
	District Patriots Travel Baseball players are expected to be committed to being a			
	Patriot! Attendance for practices and games could be used as a factor in future year's			
	tryouts and consideration. WE ASK THAT YOU PLEASE DO NOT SCHEDULE			
	VACATIONS DURING APRIL - JULY.			
Fees:	The 2024 per player fee will be \$850.00 per player. A 2 part payment plan will be			
	available with first payment due in August 2024. The fee covers uniform costs, winter			
	training, tournament/league fees, umpires, equipment, and a Patriots promotional item. Uniform includes a hat, 2 jerseys, 2 striped pants, 2 pairs of socks, 2 belts & a practice			
	t-shirt. All players new to the program will receive a batting helmet and helmet decal.			
	There will be a uniform sizing day typically in January/February.			
	Purchase of new add-on items (backpacks, new helmets) are an additional fee.
