REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- ✓ To register a team, the manager must submit league registration and full payment during the appropriate time period listed below. <u>No registration will be accepted without payment</u>. A team is not given a spot until all fees are paid. Woodbury Parks & Recreation accepts payment by cash, check, or credit card. The following is a list of different ways to register your team.
 - ONLINE: Register online at <u>https://www.woodburymn.gov/384/Recreation</u>. Click on orange box labeled register or view programs and events. You will be directed to our registration login page. Create an account and login. Once logged in, click on the search tab and select type <u>ADULT</u> <u>SPORT LEAGUES</u>. This will bring you to the list of adult leagues we are offering this upcoming season. Click on the empty square box in front of the activity #. The selected league will appear at the bottom of the screen, click "Add to Cart" button to proceed to checkout.
 - 2. **EMAIL:** Scan and email registration materials to <u>jeremy.bailey@woodburymn.gov</u>. Include credit card information on email registrations or call 651-414-3436 with your credit card payment.
 - 3. **PHONE:** Call the league director, Jeremy Bailey, at 651-414-3436 to register over the phone. Credit card payment is required. Managers need to submit a hard copy of the registration form.
 - 4. **IN-PERSON:** In-person registration is accepted at the Woodbury City Hall Welcome Desk Monday–Friday; 8:00 am–4:30 pm within the registration dates. Woodbury City Hall building address is 8301 Valley Creek Road, Woodbury, MN 55125.
 - 5. **DROP-BOX (after-hours):** Place your registration within the registration dates in a sealed envelope labeled 'VOLLEYBALL' and drop it in the after-hours in the silver utility payment deposit box located in the parking lot median at Woodbury City Hall.
 - 6. **MAIL:** Mail-in registration can be submitted within the registration dates to Woodbury Parks and Recreation Department, 8301 Valley Creek Road, Woodbury, MN 55125.

LEAGUE INFORMATION

✓ When will we know what league we got into?

You will receive a receipt when you register that will show the league your team is registered for.

What times are games played and where?
Games are played in local schools in Woodbury at 6, 7, 8, and 9 p.m. (unless otherwise noted).

✓ Do I need to send a team roster now?

No. A roster is not required until your first game. Team rosters are turned in through the league website, <u>www.teamsideline.com/woodburymn</u>. Instructions will be provided to manager in the league welcome email. Players need to be issued an email invite to join your team each session they play with your team.

✓ What are the roster and eligibility requirements?

- 1. Minimum age for players is 18.
- 2. The maximum number of players that may be on the roster is 12.

- 3. Players must be listed on the team roster in order to play in the league. **Players are only allowed to be on one team roster per league night.**
- 4. The last time on which roster changes can be made is before the third week of the season.
- 5. In the event that a team disbands before the scheduled games are complete, all the remaining games will be credited to their scheduled opponent. No refund will be made.
- 6. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to place teams in leagues or divisions where there will be equalization of competition and/or allow teams opportunity to play.

✓ When will we get our schedules?

League schedules, rules, and other important league materials will be emailed to team managers the week prior to your leagues starting date. Please make sure you provide at least one email on your registration form. Schedules, standings, and other information will be posted on the Woodbury Adult Athletics website at http://www.teamsideline.com/woodburymn prior to your 1st game.

✓ What are the Manager's Duties?

- 1. Make sure you have a full team for every game.
- 2. The manager must handle any dispute. Do not let one of your players face ejection by arguing a call.
- 3. You are responsible for taking charge of your team's and your spectator's conduct.
- 4. Any schedule information, changes, or other league information will be sent to you. Make sure we have your current email address. It is your responsibility to pass the information on to your players.
- 5. Know the rules. Tell your players the rules. This way the game will run smoothly.


✓ What is the refund/cancellation policy?

- 1. If Woodbury Parks & Recreation cancels a league due to low numbers, a full refund will be given.
- 2. If a team chooses to back out of the league after the registration deadline, no refund will be given.
- 3. If games are cancelled due to poor weather conditions or school closures and no make-up dates are available, a program credit will be issued for the amount of the official for that game.

Woodbury Park & Recreations has a Team Conduct, Eligibility, and Forfeit Fee Policy for Adult Athletic Leagues.

Teams will have to pay for the following violations before their next scheduled game. If fees are not paid before the next game, teams or players may not be allowed to play.

- <u>Alcohol Consumption</u> \$50 per incident. No alcohol can be consumed or taken into the school facilities.
- **<u>No Tobacco Products</u>** \$25 per incident. This facility is a tobacco free facility.
- **Physical contact made with an official or another player** \$50 per incident and expulsion from the league.
- Not having a complete roster on file for the current league \$25 per incident. Roster are due before the 1st game and need to be submitted electronically at http://www.teamsideline.com/woodburymn.
- <u>Player Ejection</u> \$25 per ejection. Any player who is ejected from a game, for any reason, must sit out that team's next scheduled game. If it happens again, they must sit out the next two games. For a third ejection, suspension will cover the remainder of the year.
- **<u>Ineligible/Unrostered Player</u>** \$25 per violation.
- <u>Unannounced Forfeit</u> \$25 per game. Less than 24 hours of scheduled game.
- **Loud or Vulgar Music** \$25 per incident. Loud or vulgar music is not allowed during games.

This policy will be enforced by the League Director, League Officials, Gym Supervisors and including any City of Woodbury Parks & Recreation staff members. All teams will be required to pay the required conduct fee once notified by the league director that a team and/or player violation has been made. Teams will have 48 hours to pay the fee and will not be able to continue in the league until the fee has been paid. No exceptions.

I understand and agree to the terms listed within the conduct fee policy and agree to follow the policy as stated in order to remain in good standing with the league.



Adult Volleyball Skill Definitions

Recreational (C)

- Just want to have fun!
- Do whatever necessary to get the ball over the net.
- Know the general rules of the game but may not know the more technical rules.
- 70% or less serves in play.

Rec Players often try to use three hits, but struggle with execution. Basic passing, setting and hitting skills are inconsistent, and many sets are technically carries. Hitters do not utilize a true approach. Many points are "given" to opponent due to execution errors, (i.e. shanks, bad passes etc.)

Intermediate (B)

- Usually make three hits per side.
- Have a setter, but most of the time the setter is setting from the middle position.
- Attempt to block occasionally when a hitter is front of them.
- Players play the position into which they rotate rather than assigned positions.
- Have technical knowledge of the rules.
- 70-90% of serves in play.

A solid "B" player has reasonable consistency. A few points are scored due to execution errors but not the majority, most points have to be earned. These players have typically played before in a recreational league setting.

Competitive (A)

- Can perform all skills: BLOCKING, SETTING, PASSING, and HITTING.
- Know what 5-1, 6-2, and 4-2 offenses are.
- Know how to cover the court defensively during a serve and during a hit.
- Can pass a hit or serve to the setter frequently.
- Front row hitters are able to take an approach and hit the ball consistently.
- Play with positions: outside hitter, middle hitter, right side hitter, setter and defensive specialist.
- Setters can set a basic outside, middle, and right side ball with minimal spin.
- Get 90% of serves, or more, in play.

Reserved for players who are highly competitive and only want to play with other highly competitive players. These players have typically played high school, collegiate or other elite-level volleyball.
