## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

- ✓ To register for the league, you must submit league registration and full payment during the appropriate time period listed below. **No registration will be accepted without payment.** An individual is not given a spot until all fees are paid. Woodbury Parks & Recreation accepts payment by cash, check or credit card. The following is a list of different ways to register your team.
  1. **ONLINE:** Register online at <https://www.woodburymn.gov/384/Recreation>. Click on the orange box in the middle of the page labeled register or view programs and events. You will be directed to our registration login page. Create an account and login. Once logged in, click on the search tab and select type **ADULT SPORT LEAGUES**. This will bring you to the list of adult leagues we are offering this upcoming season. Click on the empty square box in front of the activity #. The selected league will appear at the bottom of the screen, click "Add to Cart" button to proceed to checkout.
  2. **EMAIL:** Registrations can be submitted by email to [samuel.jenes@woodburymn.gov](mailto:samuel.jenes@woodburymn.gov).
  3. **PHONE:** Call Woodbury Parks and Recreation office at 651-714-3583 or the league director at 651-414-3436 to register over the phone. Credit card payment is required. Managers need to submit a hard copy of the registration and roster forms to complete the registration process.
  4. **IN-PERSON:** In-person registration is accepted at the Woodbury City Hall Welcome Desk Monday-Friday; 8:00 am-4:30 pm within the registration dates. Woodbury City Hall building address is 8301 Valley Creek Road, Woodbury, MN 55125.
  5. **DROP-BOX (after-hours):** Place your registration within the registration dates in a sealed envelope labeled 'SOCCER' and drop it in the after-hours silver utility payment deposit box located in the parking lot median at Woodbury City Hall.
  6. **MAIL:** Mail-in registration can be submitted within the registration dates to Woodbury Parks and Recreation Department, 8301 Valley Creek Road, Woodbury, MN 55125.

## **LEAGUE INFORMATION**

- ✓ **Should I buy game balls?**

Yes, all teams are asked to bring a game ball to the field on game days. **Please coordinate with your teammates to decide who will provide a game ball each week. The city will** provide a back-up game ball that can be used if both teams choose. If for some reason teams are unable to decide on a game ball, they will be asked to use the ball provided by the city.
- ✓ **What will the team sizes be?**

The league will either be 5v5, 6v6, or 8v8 depending on how many people sign up for the league. The 5v5 would be a last resort and would have no goalies. 6v6 and 5v5 would be played on a half field with smaller nets. 8v8 would be played the same as our typical 8v8 league. The rules will reflect which team size we go with when sent out.
- ✓ **What times are games played and where?**
  1. Game times will depend on the number of teams created and field availability. Game nights will generally start at 6:30 p.m. with games at 7:30, 8:30 and 9:30 p.m. unless noted otherwise.
  2. All games will be played on outdoor fields at the M Health Fairview Sports Center soccer field (size depends on game format).

✓ **What are the roster and eligibility requirements?**

1. Minimum age for players is 18.
2. Players must be listed on the team roster in order to play in the league.
3. In the event that a team disbands before the scheduled games are complete, all the remaining games will be credited to their scheduled opponent. No refund will be made.
4. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to place individuals on teams where there will be equalization of competition and/or allow teams opportunity to play.

✓ **When will we get our schedules?**

All of your information, including game schedules and rosters will be emailed to the team in a group email once teams have been assigned. One week before the league starts at the latest. League materials will also be available on the league website, [www.teamsideline.com/woodburymn](http://www.teamsideline.com/woodburymn).

✓ **What are your responsibilities to your teammates?**

1. Make sure you keep other team members informed if you wind up missing a week. Try to find a sub if at all possible.
2. You must keep yourself in check. Do not let yourself face ejection by arguing a call.
3. You are responsible for taking charge of your and your spectators conduct. **Abusive language, improper drinking, litter and other irresponsible acts will not be tolerated.**
4. Any schedule information, changes or other league information will be sent to you. Make sure we have your current email address for the current season. It is your responsibility to keep up with the information we send you.
5. Know the rules. This way the game will run smoothly & help your team concentrate on playing.

✓ **What is the refund/cancellation policy?**

1. If Woodbury Parks & Recreation cancels a league due to low numbers, a full refund will be given.
2. If an individual chooses to back out of the league after the registration deadline, no refund will be given.
3. If games are cancelled and no make-up dates are available, a program credit will be issued for the amount of the official for that game. A couple make-up dates are built into the season.

Woodbury Parks & Recreation has a Team Conduct, Eligibility, and Forfeit Fee Policy for Adult Athletic Leagues.

Teams will have to pay for the following violations before their next scheduled game. If fees are not paid before the next game, teams or players may not be allowed to play.

- **Alcohol Consumption** – \$50 per incident. No alcohol can be consumed or taken into the bench, dugout or playing field. Outside of those areas alcohol is allowed (no hard liquor or glass bottles).
- **No Tobacco Products** – \$25 per incident. M Health Fairview Sports Complex is a tobacco free facility
- **Physical contact made with an official or another player** – \$100 per incident and expulsion from the league.
- **Not having a complete roster on file for the current league** – \$25 per incident. Roster are due before the 1st game and need to be submitted electronically at <http://www.teamsideline.com/woodburymn>.
- **Player Ejection** – \$50 per ejection. Any player who is ejected from a game, for any reason, will not be allowed to play in any games the remainder of the evening **and** suspended any games the following week. The ejected player must leave the facility. Failure to comply will result in the game being declared a forfeit. If the player is ejected a second time, suspension may cover additional games or possibly the remainder of the season depending on the severity of the incident.
- **Ineligible/Unrostered Player** – \$25 per violation.
- **Unannounced Forfeit** – \$25 per game. Less than 24 hours of scheduled game.
- **Loud or Vulgar Music** – \$25 per incident. Loud or vulgar music is not allowed during games.

This policy will be enforced by the league director, City of Woodbury staff members, and league officials. All teams will be required to pay the required conduct fee once notified by the league director that a team and/or player violation has been made. Teams will have 48 hours to pay the fee and will not be able to continue in the league until the fee has been paid. No exceptions.
