PARENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following the Parents' Code of Conduct:

I WILL encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports events.

I WILL place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.

I WILL insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment and do my very best to make youth sports fun for the children.

I WILL support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I WILL remember that the game is for youth - not for adults.

I WILL help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, abiding by league rules, or assisting with other league activities.

I WILL demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.

I WILL ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

I WILL not engage in any violence or verbal threats or use any profanity towards any coach, parent, spectator, player, participant, or staff.
