HRCE Tee Ball

General Rules

- Every player will bat each inning.
- The batting order will remain the same the entire game, although coaches can choose to rotate which player bats first each inning, while keeping the order of players consistent.
- Games will be 3 innings in length, but can be shortened by mutual agreement of both coaches.
- No score is kept.
- The inning is complete when the last batter for the team has hit. This may mean that a team gets more than 3 outs per inning.
- Defensive positions should be rotated each inning.
- The pitcher and catcher should be in the proximity of their positions.
- o Infielders must be even with or deeper than than the baseline until the ball is hit.
- o Outfielders must be in the grass until the ball is hit.
- o Basepaths are 50 feet.
- The catcher should wear a batting helmet to reduce the risk of errant bats and balls hitting anyone's head.
