

## LYB Board Meeting – 12/16/2025

1. Banquet Food Ideas:
  - a. Feedback from last season: Took a long time to get through. By the time the second half of people were getting their food, the first half was already done eating.
    - i. Solution: 2 lines! One on each side of the Lonestar Hall.
  - b. The board put out various ideas for food options. Each member will get a quote on what the cost would be.

    - iii. Cameron – Torchy's Tacos catering
    - iv. Jason – Brooklyn Heights pizza/pasta/wings/salad
  - c. Budget will include the food and décor for tables and stage for pictures.
