## **MOORE TOURNAMENTS RULES**

Rules: All play is governed by USA Rules. Any exceptions are listed.

- 1. The home team will be decided by a flip of a coin throughout Pool Play.
- 2. In Bracket Play the Higher Seeded Team will be the Home Team
- 3. Teams not available to begin at game time will forfeit. TEAMS MUST BE READY TO PLAY 15 MINUTES PRIOR THEIR SCHEDULED START TIME.
- 4. There will be no warm-ups on the infields prior to any game. The outfields may be used. There is plenty of open area and diamonds around the facility.
- 5. The Home Team will act as the official scorer and line-ups must be exchanged prior to game time.
- 6. The official game time for the is **1 hour and 15 minutes or 7 innings** whichever comes first. No new inning may begin after 1 hour and 15 minutes. The **Championship Games** will be **1 hour and 30 minutes or 7 innings.**
- 7. If the game is tied at the end of 7 innings or when an inning is completed at the end of regulation time, the International Tiebreaker Rule will be used in Bracket Play only. (POOL GAMES can end in a TIE)
- 8. Head coaches are to verify the starting time with the umpire prior to the start of the game. The umpire is the official timekeeper.
- 9. Mercy Rule is as follows:
  At the end of 3 innings if a team is winning by 12 runs or more the game is over, and the score is final. At the 4 innings the run rule is 10 runs and at the end of 5 innings the run rule is 8 runs. (12 3, 10 4, and 8 5)
- 10. The Plate Umpire is responsible for the official score card. Team representatives are responsible to verify the final score with the plate umpire.
- 11. Teams may bat their entire roster throughout the tournament.
