Scholarship Application form and additional information are available online. Holland residents may apply for scholarship programs. Scholarship applications must be submitted one week prior to regular program registration deadline.

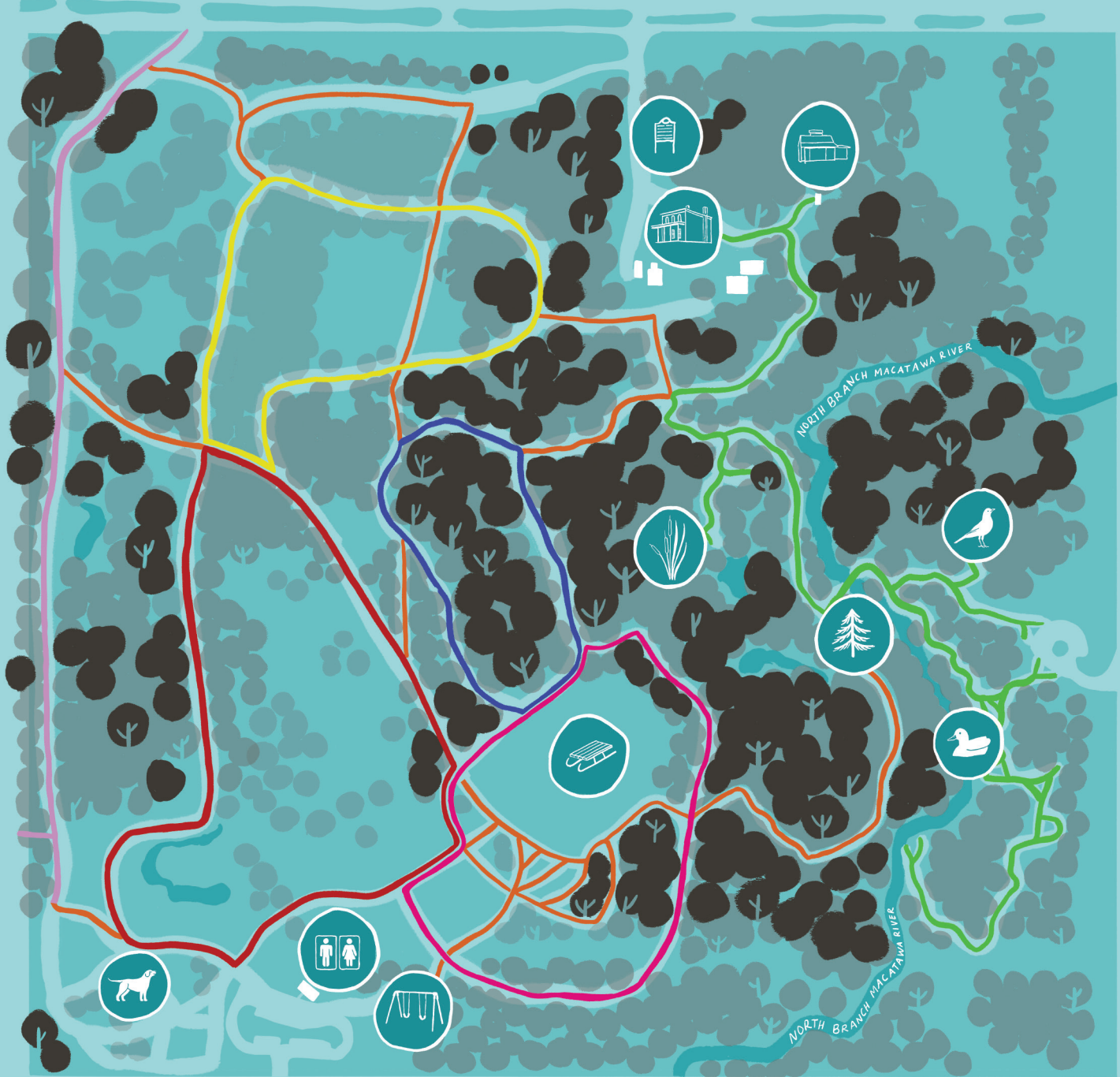

Van Raalte Farm

Overview

As the largest park maintained by Holland Parks and Recreation, Van Raalte Farm, boasts 160 acres of natural landscapes and an intricate trail system. Over 3 miles of hiking and cross-country ski trails are maintained year-round, making the park a popular destination.

Van Raalte Farm is significant to the history of Holland, because Reverend Albertus Van Raalte, founding father of the City of Holland, purchased the land from the federal government over 140 years ago for \$2.32 per acre. Van Raalte Farm is still the site of a nineteenth century farmhouse and outbuildings set on a hilltop overlooking pasture and woodlands that include a valley and a branch of the Black River. Shortly after the Civil War, the barns were built, and then in 1872 the house, once referred to as "The Maples", was started. The land remained in the Van Raalte family until it was purchased by the City of Holland in 1983 for \$350,000.

Dog Park

The Dog Park at Van Raalte, located within Van Raalte Farm, offers three acres of fenced-in safety, mature shade trees, and includes a separate area for small dogs. The dog park is also equipped with drinking stations for dogs, a walking path, and agility stations. The entrance to the dog park is conveniently located near the rest of the Van Raalte Farm trail system, making it easy to explore all of Van Raalte Farm with your furry friend on a leash. Currently, the Dog Park at Van Raalte Farm is the only dog park located within city limits. The dog park was added to Van Raalte Farm in 2021, and has seen heavy use by City of Holland residents since then.

Accessing Van Raalte Farm

Parking at Van Raalte Farm is available off of 16th Street, 24th Street and Country Club Road, providing access to nature trails, picnic shelter, play structures, as well as winter sledding and cross-country skiing.

The Dog Park at Van Raalte is open daily year-round from 6:00 AM - 11:00 PM. It is accessible from the 24th Street entrance to Van Raalte Farm. See map on opposite page.

Improvements Coming to Van Raalte Farm in 2024

Residents of Holland can look forward to an improved Van Raalte Farm in 2024. New trail signage will increase the usability of the Van Raalte Farm trail system, making it an even more enjoyable experience to get out and explore.

Centennial Park Gazebo

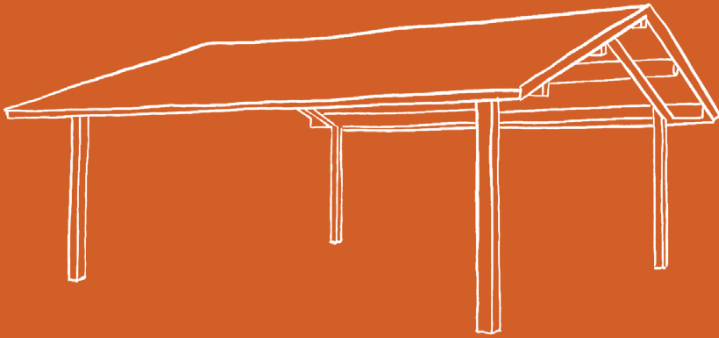

Maplewood Youth Sports Complex
