Holland Ice Park

The new Holland Ice Park is located on the site of Window on the Waterfront Park, on 6th Street, near the corner of College Avenue. When the project is complete it will include a circular ice pond with a connected ribbon and a separate curling rink.

Amenities of the Ice Park will include skate rentals, concessions, and restrooms. The plaza area will offer the added benefit of snowmelt and three fireplaces to keep visitors warm. In the Ice Park's off season, the facility will be utilized by Holland Parks & Recreation to offer additional programming.




Timeline of a Tulip


