Player Evaluations & Draft Rules Procedures

Player Evaluations

- 1. All players ages 7 and up are required to attend the Player Assessment Combine.
- **2.** A minimum of 1 coach from each team is required to attend the Player Assessment Combine to give an evaluation grade.
- **3.** Coaches must use the evaluation format provided by the league. Additional and separate note-taking is permitted.
- **4.** Coach's will make their own assessment grade of all players.
- **5.** Players will perform up to 5 drills during Player Assessment to showcase speed, agility, catching, and passing.
- **6.** Players will be assessed in numerical order per numbers assigned by the league.
- **7.** All players who do not attend the Assessment Combine will not receive a grade and will be placed on a team randomly per the draft procedure.

Flag Football Draft Procedure

- 1. The order of the draft will be determined by head coach's names drawn from a hat.
- 2. The format will be a "snake draft." For example, for a league with 10 teams, we would draft 1-10 and then go back 10-1. This means that one coach will have back-to-back picks for every round.
- **3.** Players who attended the Player Assessment Combine and who have an evaluation grade will be drafted first.
- 3. When all players with an evaluation grade have been drafted the players who did not attend the Assessment Combine will be placed randomly onto teams with the hat pick system.
- **4.** Every coach will have a maximum of 2 minutes to make each pick.

- **5.** The draft will conclude when the last player has been drafted. This may result in some teams having more/less total amounts of players.
- **6.** Siblings that are registered in the same league must be picked onto the same team. The sibling will be picked in the next round unless all coaches agree to adjust the assigned round to the second sibling based on the assessment grade. This will be decided prior to the start of the draft.
- **7.** Only the head coach's son/daughter is a protected player and will be auto-picked in the 3rd round. The assistant coach child is not protected.
- **8.** Trading picks or players is prohibited.
- **9.** Children or players are not permitted to attend the draft.
- **10.** Any Head Coach or Assistant Coach who is found to have intentionally manipulated the evaluation or draft process will be removed from the position of coach and a new coach will be assigned. Depending on the severity of the offense the league has the right to order a redraft or apply a game penalty to the team.
