

All-Star Managers Selection Process

- 1. In order to be eligible to manage an All-Star team an individual must:
 - a. Be a volunteer in good standing with the league
 - i. Be free of misconduct on and off the field
 - ii. Not been sanctioned for not following the rules during gameplay
 - iii. Not have been ejected from a game, with no change to that ejection upon appeal
 - b. Be a rostered manager coach for the current season
 - c. Declare their interest to the League.
 - d. You can only be a Manager for All-Stars within the division you Managed/Coached in during the current spring season (unless extenuating circumstances such as no manager/coach interested within the division).
- 2. <u>Managers and protected coaches</u> will vote for their choice in the league age(s) in the division they coached in.
 - a. Coaches must be declared to the league by the second Saturday of the Spring season, to be eligible to vote. (Only the manager and one protected coach will be allowed to vote per team).
- 3. The top vote-getters in each age/division will be presented to the league.
 - a. The Board will have final approval over all candidates selected based on the above vote. In order to remove a selected candidate the league <u>must</u> have a significant cause.
 - b. If there is a tie after the manager and coach votes, the candidates will be presented to the board and will be allowed to speak to the board and present their qualifications.
