The Rules continued

- ▶Game Times
 - ►Micro-2nd Grade four 8-minute quarters, running clock
 - ▶3rd-4th grade four 8-minute quarters, clock stops last min. of each quarter
- ▶Ball Size
 - ▶Micro Kindergarten: 22 size basketballs and shoot on eight-foot baskets.
 - ▶1st 2nd Grades: 27.5 size basketball and shoot on eight-foot baskets.
 - ▶3rd and 4th Grade Girls: 27.5 size basketball and shoot on ten-foot baskets.
 - ▶3rd thru 6th Grade Boys: 28.5 size basketball and shoot on ten-foot baskets
 - ▶ Equipment may change pending availability.
 - ▶There is NO overtime period.

The Rules continued-Special Rules:

No Pressing

 Teams must retreat to beyond the half court before applying pressure to the offense even on fast breaks.

No Foul Outs

There will be no three (3) seconds in the lane violation

There will be no five (5) second possession violation.

There will not be a ten (10) seconds half court rule.

There will be no over and back called.

Stealing off the dribble is only allowed for Grades

Defense/Pressing by Grade

- Micro 2nd Grades: Only man to man defense is allowed. No pressing is allowed. Each team will be provided with a set of colored wrist bands to help with defense.
- 3rd 4th Grades: Only man to man defense is allowed. No pressing is allowed.
- 1st 4th Grades: Since only man to man defense is allowed, there will be no trapping/double teaming.


