CENTRAL KANSAS BASKETBALL LEAGUE RULES

Participants

- 1. Central Kansas Basketball League (CKBBL) is for youth in 1st-6th grades.
- 2. The players' grade they are currently enrolled in shall determine the division they are eligible to participate in. Players may play up one division.

Rosters/Players

- 1. Teams joining the CKBBL will be already formed.
- 2. Only a player appearing on the official team roster on file with the League Coordinator will be eligible to play in any regular league games. Players who are not already part of a CKBBL roster may be added to a team throughout the season. Coaches need to notify the League Coordinator 48 hours before game time and be approved before he/she can play in that game. Call (620) 663-6179 or e-mail Garrett Huddleston ghuddleston@hutchrec.com, to add the player.
- 3. Players may only be assigned to one CKBBL team. They cannot play for multiple teams in the same age division or for multiple teams in different age divisions.
- 4. A player cannot change teams once a signed roster has been submitted and accepted by the League Coordinator.
- 6. No refunds will be given once the league schedule is out.

KSHSAA rules will be followed except for the following:

- 1. Two 20-minute halves will be played with a running clock, except for the last 2 minutes of each half. If a team is ahead by 15 or more points in the last two minutes of each half, the clock will continue to run. Teams will enter the bonus at 7 team fouls each half. Teams will shoot two free throws once the bonus is reached.
- 2. In the event of a tie, one 2-minute overtime will be played. The clock will stop on all dead balls. If the game is still tied after conclusion of overtime, it will end in a tie.
- 3. There will be a 5-minute warm up and a 5-minute halftime of each game.
- Four timeouts are allowed per game: (2) full timeouts and (2) 30-second timeouts.
- 5. All games will start at the designated time. Teams must have a minimum of 4 players to start or continue a game. If a team is unable to start at game time or continue the game with the minimum number of players required, that team shall forfeit the game.
- 6. Any coach that receives a technical foul during a game will lose his/her privilege to stand and coach. That coach must remain seated for the remainder of the game. Any coach that is ejected (2 technical fouls) must leave the facility immediately. Before an ejected coach is allowed to coach again, he/she must meet with Hutch Rec Staff to determine any other consequences of their actions. Any assistant coach that receives a technical foul will cause the head coach to lose their standing privileges.
- 7. Hutch Rec will not provide scorekeepers. One parent from each team will be required to run the scoreboard and the scorebook. Parents must be ready by game time.



CENTRAL KANSAS BASKETBALL LEAGUE: DIVISION-SPECIFIC RULES

1st/2nd Grade Division Rules

1. Goal Height: 9 feet

2. Ball Size: 28.5"

3. No full court pressing is allowed in this division.

4. Free throw line will be at 12 foot. Players must start behind the line, but no free throw violation will be called unless crossing prior to the shot. Other players lining up for free throws will play high school rules.

3rd/4th Grade Division Rules

1. Goal Height: 9 feet

2. Ball Size: 28.5"

3. No full court pressing is allowed in this division.

5th/6th Grade Division Rules

1. Goal Height: 10 feet

2. Ball Size: 28.5"

3. Full court pressing is allowed except for the last two minutes of the game if a team is ahead by 15 or more points. Please use good sportsmanship.
