Our philosophy within The City of Loveland Parks and Recreation Department is to provide quality Youth Athletics programs that promote skill development, equal participation, sportsmanship, fun, and friendly competition in a positive, safe, and recreational setting.

As a parent/guardian of a player in a Parks & Recreation youth athletic program, I understand that I have a responsibility as a role model and that my actions are visible to players, parents, umpires and league officials. Therefore, I agree to uphold the following standards:

- 1. Respect the sports environment it's an outdoor classroom!
- 2. Make only positive, encouraging comments to players on both teams. I will refrain from using profanity of any kind at any time.
- 3. Never criticize a child for making a mistake, as mistakes are part of the learning process.
- 4. Discuss any concern away from the players and in particular the child.
- 5. Respect the officials and the volunteer coaches.
- 6. Focus on FUN and participation, not winning.
- 7. Control my emotions.
- 8. Seek feedback from the child on whether they are having fun or not, and if not, why?
- 9. Get interested in the sport learn the rules.
- 10. Make every effort to get my child to practice and games on time.
- 11. Pick my child up on time from practice and games.
- 12. Reinforce the coach's instructions when practicing with the child.
- 13. Never undermine team morale.
- 14. Keep the coaches informed if the child has to miss a practice or a game.
- 15. Participate in team/league activities.
- 16. Refrain from using tobacco, drugs and alcohol at all youth sports events.
