## D5 Meeting

• Nothing to report on last meeting

#### Spring ball

- November 1<sup>st</sup> target open date to open registration
- Need to get flyers out before winter break
  - Target deadline for approval on flyers is November 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Fees need update
  - o Need to remove try-out dates
- Registration
  - o Fees
    - Due for an increase
    - Would be a slight increase, last time we increased was ~ ¾ years ago
    - Scott suggested \$25+
    - Current registration for everything other than t-ball is \$160 / t-ball is \$60
      - Sandra suggested below fee schedule for all divisions with exception of t-ball
        - An "early bird" registration of \$160 in November
        - Increase to \$175 in December
        - January increase to \$200
        - o Vote passed
      - Karlianna suggested increasing t-ball, we could stagger price like other divisions
        - "Early bird" starts at \$60 in November
        - Increase to \$70 in December
        - January 1<sup>st</sup> we would increase to \$80
        - Vote passed
      - Senior fees
        - Need to consider raising fees
        - Our cost is much lower than other leagues
        - Seniors won't be going until May, need to talk about this come February/March
        - Wouldn't consider late fee for them

- Not deciding on this now but Colin suggested raising similar to regular fees (\$25)
- Sign-ups

- Karlianna suggested adding an option on registration for experience level
  - Would be leveraged to help understand experience for kids and if they are truly ready for the division they are registering for
  - Coaches can also encourage players to play down or play up based on what they see during try-outs or practice
- o Try-outs
  - We are only required to do 1 try-out per Little League International
  - Probably want to do at least 2, maybe a 3<sup>rd</sup> due to walk-ons
  - Dates
    - Jan 6, 13, 17<sup>th</sup> or 18<sup>th</sup> and then possibly the 20<sup>th</sup> depending on rain delays
    - Aim to do draft either on or by the 27th
    - Order needs to be put in for jerseys by 2/3
  - Location
    - Prefer to have here at our field
    - Maidu as an optional alternative location if weather fails
- Opening Day
  - Colin suggested March 16<sup>th</sup> just to give us a little extra time to get ready for the season. Would allow us to be the "odd-ball" league with a different start date than others.
  - Everyone agreed on 16<sup>th</sup>
  - As we get closer in Dec/January we can decide on pictures
    - Wanting to get a new vendor this year
    - Everyone can start researching options now
  - Safety meeting
    - We will figure out in November

- Events for games
  - o Costumes
- Bounce House Provider

- Jen found another bounce house company that will donate their bounce houses twice a year. We just need to put their banner up. We would just pay for generators.
  - Scott mentioned we have our own generators that we can use
  - Jen and Julie already have volunteers
  - Would be here towards the end of the day/afternoon, around 3pm
- Vendors coming out for booths
  - Texas Roadhouse will be out here (doing face paint)
  - Orthodontist (will have some games)
- Candy for kids
  - o Each team will have their own candy bags made for them
  - SLL to provide candy
- Food
  - Taco truck vendor can no longer be here
  - Talked about board members cooking pulled pork and bringing it up to the field. We will have a sauce station out front. Will need to get lots of rolls.
