Ever wonder how those teams get to the Little League World Series on ESPN in late August? For many of those parents of All-Stars who aren't quite sure where your next game will be. We have listed all the various 2024 tournament levels for each division.

### Little League (10-12's) All-Star Tournament Information

### District Level

We host a double elimination tournament with the 11 Little League teams that are in our District. The District tournament runs June 22<sup>nd</sup> - July 5<sup>th</sup>. The winner of the District 33 tournament advances to Sectional level.

### Section Level

We are in Section 6, which includes the following Districts: District 31, District 32, District 33 and District 70. The games will be played July 12<sup>th</sup> - July 18<sup>th</sup>. District 33 is hosting the games at San Carlos Little League. The winner of this tournament will advance to the State level.

### Southern California State

Southern California State is made up of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10. Southern California will have one tournament with all 10 sections participating to determine the state winner. This tournament will be hosted by District 72 in Norco area from July 20<sup>th</sup>- July 29<sup>th</sup>. The winner of this tournament will advance to the Western Regional level.

### Western Region

The California State Champions (North and South) and the 2 other State Champions will play August 3<sup>rd</sup> - August 9<sup>th</sup> in San Bernardino, California. The winner will advance to the Little League World Series.

### Little League World Series

10 US Regional winners will play August 14<sup>th</sup> - August 25<sup>th</sup> in the Little League World Series in Williamsport, Pennsylvania. 10 International teams and 10 US teams will play in the tournament this year.

### District Level

Our District tournament runs June 23<sup>rd</sup> - July 15<sup>th</sup>. The winner of the District tournament advances to Sectional level.

Section Level

We are in Section 6, which includes the following Districts: District 31, District 32, District 33 and District 70. The games will be played July 12<sup>th</sup> - July 18<sup>th</sup>. District 70 is hosting these games in the Vista area. The winner of this tournament will advance to the State level.

### Southern California State

Southern California State is made up of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10. Southern California will have one tournament with all 10 sections participating to determine the state winner. All Sectional winners play in a State Tournament from July 20<sup>th</sup> - July 29<sup>th</sup>. District 58 in the Yucaipa area will be hosting this tournament.

### District Level

Our District tournament runs June 20<sup>th</sup> - July 3<sup>rd</sup>. The winner of the District 33 tournament advances to Sectional level.

### Section Level

We are in Section 6, which includes the following Districts: District 31, District 32, District 33 and District 70. The games will be played July 12<sup>th</sup> - July 18<sup>th</sup>. District 32 is hosting the games in the Mira Mesa area. The winner of this tournament will advance to the State level.

### Southern California State

Southern California State is made up of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10. Southern California will have one tournament with all 10 sections participating to determine the state winner.
