* "Threshold used for Days Rest": Per the EXCEPTION above, if a pitcher reaches a Day(s) of Rest Threshold he/she can continue to pitch to that batter and only be charged the Day(s) of Rest for that threshold.

In the "Example" above, the pitcher started pitching to the last batter on pitch # 64 (the last "X"), reached 65 pitches and continued pitching to that batter and ended up throwing 67 pitches. The pitcher did not pitch to another (subsequent) batter. Per the Threshold Exception, since the pitcher reached/passed a threshold while facing his/her last batter, the pitcher's days rest is based on throwing 51-65 pitches (3 days of rest) not > 65 pitches (4 days of rest).
