



FALL 2024 ADULT BASKETBALL MANAGERS' MEETING RECAP

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1. All league information, including Program Flyers, Managers' Packet, Schedules, Standings, & ADD/DROP Form are available online at: <https://www.teamsideline.com/sites/cityofsantamaria/home>
 - Managers must ensure players are responsible to know and understand ALL league rules and regulations. Team/Player Suspensions are clearly outlined in manager's packet.
2. Divisions are designed with emphasis on comparability. Our goal is to level the playing field and allow all teams to compete. Team experience, caliber of roster and past league standings will determine positioning.
3. Whenever possible, the full divisional schedule will be published. Otherwise, 1st & 2nd half schedules will be used. Teams can potentially be moved at the mid-season break to another night as deemed necessary.
4. Participants must play in 4 league games during the regular season to be eligible for playoffs.
5. Reminder: Any questionable team names deemed offensive or inappropriate are not allowed. Please keep team names family/recreational friendly.
6. Add/Drop Deadline is 4 days after the first scheduled game.
 - a. Once a team has been registered for league, only the designated team manager may add two (2) players to their original roster.
 - b. Forms can also be submitted during designated Mid-Season Break.
7. After the ADD/DROP period concludes, only Emergency ADDS with written request will be considered. Teams must be down to 6 players due to injuries, work transfers, etc. to be eligible.
8. Free Agents list is available for teams looking for additional players who are new to area.
9. During the first week of play, arrive early to have all players sign the participant waiver and show photo ID. Minimum Age Requirement: participants must be 18 years of age during the season to be eligible.

10. Permanent jersey numbers must be affixed to uniform, numbers placed with marker, duct tape etc. is not permitted. Players should keep same number throughout the season. Uniform tops must be the same color.
11. Referee fee of \$30 per team is due prior to the start of the game. Games will not begin until Referee is paid. In the event of a forfeit, fee is \$60 to offending team unless 48-hr. notice is given.
12. Reminders:
 - a. Outside Food/Beverages are not permitted in the gym; except for water.
 - b. Participants can have sports drink or water in the team bench.
 - c. Only team participants are permitted on team bench.
 - d. Children must be accompanied by an adult and are not to be allowed on team benches
 - e. Parking at Edwards. Players and spectators can be cited when not parking in designated areas. Ex: Bus stop.
 - f. Balls being bounced on sidelines is not permitted.
13. No Slam Dunking or attempting to slam dunk, grasping the rims or nets is allowed. Penalty: Player will be ejected from the game and will serve an additional two (2) week suspension.
