Attendance:

A. Welcome and introductions

Introduce Marne as our new Sponsorship person. Intros all around.

B. January Meeting minutes sent in a google doc. Sent out a couple weeks back.

C. Treasurer's Report-Cindi & Janelle

Cindi and Janelle are making the books settle between the two merged leagues. Cindi has the financials and the year to date budget. Still resolving payments between the leagues from last year. Big income is registration. Big deposits coming in from online registration -- end of January at \$12K, comparable to last year at this time. Next big bills are uniforms (\$15K). Last year, we brought in \$40K in registration. Cindi feels we may take a hit due to the Sellwood recruiting. We will make it up in registration, sponsorships. Trying to make a profit. Concessions may be up from last year -- Gary and Cindi are on this and Square is working well so far, in testing phase. Maybe do a fundraiser in mid-Spring. We will be competing against the Sellwood group.

Gear swap -- Cindi did this on her front porch and it went really well and easily. Can someone host this -- socks, mitts, t-shirts, bats, shoes, etc. It went well and was easy. We will do it for sure at the March event, but we should also have it at someone's house, just whenever.

Fundraiser -- We got a Burgerville night --> 20% of proceeds. Cindi will post it on FB for volunteers.

D. Old Business:

Registration Update

Matt says we're up to 260+ kids; we have 75 t-ball(looking at 180 t-ballers by the end); 5 jr. softball; 11 major softball; 9 for minors softball; 1 farm softball; 30+ rookies -- all these numbers are general; see the report for actuals. Matt is a bit unsure of how it stacks up as compared to last year.

a. Marketing plan

Banners and lawn signs are here -- "SE Little League plays here!" We have some misprinted one-sided posters that can go into windows and stuff. The two-sided ones will come tomorrow. We have banners to hang, lawn signs to post, etc. Whoever can post them in their lawns should do so.

E. Officer Reports

- 1. Keith-Uniforms-will be ready to hand out at the March meeting, patches are being ordered by Heather and will be sent to either new PO box or directly to Colette. Higher cost this year because we are buying more for the upper divisions.
- 2. Heather-PDX turned in park permits. Ordering patches and extra rule books. Scholarship thank you notes filled out and ready to be mailed. Updated website for online volunteer registration that will go directly to Jerome. Forms should be kept for two years before being shredded. Cindi stressed the importance of keeping the info/forms safe to avoid identity theft.

Matt -- Umpire camp. 2/21 to San Bernardino, he will send updates from the road, and will recruit some umps after his return. He also wants to do sessions with coaches in a classroom setting. Matt will also put ads out for umpires.

Cindi -- We could do a raffle with Mariners tickets. Sell a package -- Amtrak tickets, or Bolt bus. We can talk later about this.

Marne -- She is dropping off forms at local businesses and will do follow-up calls (i.e., Pizza Roma, Portland Fish Market, etc.). Old businesses first, banners, will post our sponsors as soon as they are confirmed. If we can add people to the Sponsorship Committee, that would be helpful so Colette could spend her time elsewhere. There is a Google Doc to track who is doing what in terms of sponsorship.

Janelle -- Checks for the assessments should go to the school programs the day of.

Julie -- Concentrating on assessments and registration. There are a lot of families who haven't yet signed up, so she will be contacting families personally. Scheduling meeting is last weekend of Spring Break, 3/29.

Jerome -- Safety plan is done, just needs to be sent off. We had about 50 teams last year; we are short on First Aid kits so we will probably order some. About \$15 each, will need 10. 3/2 & 3/4 at Meals on Wheels -- Coaches safety meeting, 7pm. There will be a presentation by a professional. Add this to the calendar.

Kerry -- Will work with Marne to put together a boosted post in the next week re: registration.
