### A. President's Report

- 2. Treasurer-Powell & PDX-budget doing good; no end of the season awards/gift; on the dot for uniforms; split at the end-July, end of fiscal year end of Sept.; had a good financial year means we have to file a 990
- 3. Alpenrose-Josha
  - Remember-no snack shack duties-50/50 raffle instead, Josha will notify them.
