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## **VOLUNTEER BACKGROUND SCREENING POLICY**

## Description

In order to preserve the safety and well-being of participants in its programs, the Wake Forest Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Department requires background checks on all volunteers. Volunteers must submit background screen information and successfully pass all requirements prior to being approved to serve as a Volunteer in WFPRCR programs.

This policy will include all volunteers (on an annual basis) that may, in the course of their volunteer service, have the opportunity to be alone with children during activities scheduled for WFPRCR programs. Others with incidental contact with children will not be subject to provisions of this policy at this time, although WFPRCR reserves the right to conduct random checks of volunteers periodically.

If any disqualifying information is found that prevents an applicant from being accepted, potential volunteers will receive a Pre-Adverse Action Letter along with a copy of the criminal report, FCRA Consumer Rights and dispute instructions that will direct the applicant to the background screen provider's Research Team for guidance and a re-investigation if applicable.

#### Standards

Applicants shall be disqualified from consideration for Team Manager ("head coach") if applicant has ever been found guilty or entered a plea of guilty, *nolo contendre* (no contest), or *Alford Pleas*, regardless of the adjudication, for any of the following:

#### **FELONIES**

• **All Felony Violence** – regardless of the amount of time since the offense.

Examples include: murder, manslaughter, aggravated assault, kidnapping, robbery, aggravated burglary, etc.

• All Felony offenses other than violence or sex within the past ten (10) years.

Examples include: drug offenses, theft, embezzlement, fraud, child endangerment, etc.

#### **SEX OFFENSES**

All Sex Offenses – regardless of the amount of time since the offense.
 Examples include child molestation, rape, sexual assault, sexual battery, sodomy, prostitution, solicitation, indecent exposure, etc.

#### **MISDEMEANORS**

All misdemeanor violence offenses within the past seven (7) years.

Examples include: simple assault, battery, domestic violence, hit & run, etc.

• Two or more misdemeanor drug and alcohol offenses with the past seven (7) years.

Examples include: driving under the influence, simple drug possession, drunk and disorderly, public intoxication, possession of drug paraphernalia, etc.

• **Any other misdemeanor** within the past five (5) years that would be considered a potential danger to children or is directly related to the functions of the volunteer.

### **PENDING CASES**

No person shall be permitted to volunteer that has been charged with any of the Disqualifying offenses or has case(s) pending in court until the official adjudication of the case(s).

Should any pending charges be discovered, or should any charges be brought against an Applicant during the season, the Applicant shall be suspended from serving as a volunteer until such time as the charges have been cleared or dropped and he/she is reinstated by WFPRCR.

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
