

2024-25 Bus Transportation to the Boys & Girls Club from local schools

In order to have your child(ren) ride the bus to the Boys & Girls Club of the South Coast Area (BGCSCA) from their school you must obtain a bus pass. For a stop at BGCSCA, the **bus pass application window is 9am on June 3rd through 1pm on June 28th.** Bus pass applications may be submitted to the CUSD Transportation Office in person or by USPS mail (online is not an option). The spots will fill up quickly, so please start the process early. The BGCSCA is not accepting or processing any applications, you must work with the CUSD Transportation office. What you need from us is to be enrolled in our after school program, which is all done online at BGCSCA.ORG. Some ELOP families qualify for financial assistance for bus passes, please contact ELOP directly for details, Alma 949-234-9248. Some schools have very limited bus seating capacity available. Students who do not receive a pass due to over capacity will be placed on a wait list in the order received. Unfortunately, if an application is submitted after June 28, Transportation cannot guarantee a bus pass will be issued in time for the first day the club re-opens. A bus pass is required to ride the bus.

Las Palmas (from school directly to Club):

Marblehead (from Marblehead directly to the Club):

- only 10 seats available

- Pay the district transportation fees (or qualify for free or reduced fees)
- Must show proof of enrollment in our after-school program for the 2024-25 school year at the time the application is submitted. <u>2024-25 After School Program</u> www.bgcsca.org/afterschool

Marblehead ESSA Students (from Marblehead to Las Palmas to the Club):

- Must apply with CUSD District Office or school site. Transportation request forms were sent out in March. We understand most have been returned already. If you've returned your Transportation request form, you will just need to be sure the CUSD Transportation Office receives your proof of enrollment in our after-school program for the 2024-25 school year.
- Parent will need proof of enrollment to request an alternate stop to BGCSCA.

Shorecliffs (from school, stops along the way at approved stops, the Club is also an alternate stop):

- only 10 seats available

Bernice Ayer Middle School (BAMS) (from school directly to Club):

- Must show proof of enrollment in our after-school program for the 2024-25 school year at the time the application is submitted. <u>2024-25 After School Program</u> www.bgcsca.org/afterschool
- Currently this bus is scheduled to leave after the first bus returns, so after the bell students will
 remain on-site for supervised homework help for 30-40 minutes until the bus returns. They will
 then take the bus to BGCSCA.
- i. Your child must behave on the bus. If your child misbehaves, they risk losing the privilege of riding the bus to the Boys & Girls Club. Refunds will not be given if your child is removed from the bus for poor behavior.
- ii. If your child is regularly using bus transportation from school to the Club, and then being picked up immediately to go home and not participating in our after school program, your bus spot will be given to another family who needs this service.
- iii. Per the transportation office, if it is deemed the student has not used their bus pass for 10 consecutive school days, it may be cancelled and his/her seat on the bus forfeited.
- iv. Transportation is not offered from Vista Del Mar and Truman Benedict, we apologize for the inconvenience.
