II. Items from President

Mario Luna asked if there is a resolution for the team's player cards for this weekend. Bill Pevernik replied that if the team roster from last year will suffice and if they don't have one a handwritten list of players will be accepted.

Ryan Hill introduced & welcomed Jose Alvarez welcomed to the 405 FC Board.

Bill Pevarnik asked what the dates are for inhouse registration to begin. March 25, 2023, and PAL starts April 1, 2023, and adult's deadline is anticipated to be March 19, 2023.

Wayne Williams asked if there is a contact for organizing a focus for kids who are middle school age. Bill Pevernik suggested to contact the school in the fall and Dicks Sporting goods has a history to donate and or support team play, also he encouraged to make contacts with many resources that will support the underserved population. Ryan Hill explained that the recreation department is already building a relationship with public schools.

Jose Alvarez commented there may be an opportunity to have an open house for schools and the community. The open house would provide the program and provide a positive resource for kids to play.

Wayne Williams inquired is there a process to gather date to show which schools would need to be focused on. Ryan Hill responded the data from registration can be retrieved and will provide those specific details.

The academy deadline was in January and at this time 405 FC did not meet that deadline, but Jose Alvarez will be following closely of when the 405 FC Academy can get registered.

Ryan Hill reported that there are some teams that have not returned due to the conflicts with the football program and field access, and unform ordering will be placed soon.

Bill Pevernik asked if the coaches are still being registered US Soccer, and if they are OK DL, they have to have a minimum of a D license for coaching. There is a one-year grant from OSA that aides those to get the D License. Ryan Hill responded yes, our coaches have to have the Grass Roots Certification, they have to pass a minimum. Bill Pevernik confirmed have a D License is required by US and OSA Soccer clubs.
