TRI-VALLEY CHRISTIAN ATHLETIC LEAGUE VOLLEYBALL RULES

These rules are for explanation or to note exceptions to CIF rules.

If any rules are not on here, then CIF rules will apply.

- Rally scoring is used for all sets (Best 2 out of 3). A point will be scored on each serve.
 Must win a set by two points with no cap.
- 2. Sets 1 and 2 are to 25 points and set 3 (if necessary) will be to 15 points.
- 3. Each team will have two time-outs per set. Time-outs do not carry over.
- 4. Coin-toss
 - a. Prior to the match: Home team will choose what side they sit on first. Away team will call the toss. Winner chooses to either serve or receive.
 - b. Prior to 3rd set: Away team will call the toss. Winner chooses to either serve or receive. Loser chooses the side they want to sit on.
- 5. Teams will switch sides between sets, never during a set.
- 6. The receiving team will always rotate after winning a point, even on the first serve of the set.
- 7. The height of the net for junior high will be 7'4" and the height for elementary will be 6'6".
- 8. A toss is not required on an underhand serve.
- Poles must be padded to play. Home team will forfeit if poles are not padded, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 10. No jewelry is allowed. Any player wearing jewelry will not be allowed to play. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 11. Each team is required to provide a line judge to assist the referee.
- 12. **For elementary only:** servers may step over the end line but must start behind the end line.
- 13. **For junior high only:** A libero may be used but is not required. If a team uses a libero, a libero tracker must be seated at the scores table and cannot be a coach.
