Adult Arena Soccer Leagues Team Manager Responsibilities

The team manager is responsible for the team's adherence to all of the following:

- All players must be registered to play by having completed the online registration, which consists of a registration, signed waiver and signed code of conduct, plus paying the league fees. The player payment must be made prior to the beginning of the team's first game of the current season.
- Managers are responsible for ensuring that their team adheres to the YMCA Facility and Arena Rules and Regulations. If you are unable to attend the game, there must be another player appointed responsible for the team. In the case that a manager cannot attend a game, he/she must notify the YMCA staff of which registered player will act on his/her behalf for that game.
- Manager is responsible to control their players' and spectators' behavior and language. NO FOOD will be allowed in/around the arena.
- All players must be age appropriate for the division. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- All teams must have a uniform that includes shirts (**permanent numbers and same color**), socks, and shin- guards. No jewelry. No hard casts or braces.
- All players must have a valid Player ID card issued within the current year by the Fullerton Family YMCA by the first game they play in.
- Players must have their Fullerton YMCA issued Player ID card at every game. If a player does not have their YMCA ID card they may not be permitted to play.
- Manager(s) must attend the mandatory manager meeting or send a substitute.
- If a team cannot field enough players, the manager must notify the YMCA 24 hours or more prior to game time by e-mail to: jcarper@ymcaoc.org. The cancellation/forfeit fee (if less than 24hours' noticee) will be \$30.00. If a team needs to cancel a game within 24 hours of game time, the manager must contact the YMCA at: (714) 879-9622 immediately and email jcarper@ymcaoc.org
- All teams must pick up trash around arena after each game.
- Manager is responsible for notifying players of schedule changes / cancellations (if any).
- **Manager will inform their team not to use the YMCA facility unless they are a facility member.**
- Spectators/children may only be in the blacktop area surrounding the arena.
- Players and spectators who are not YMCA facility members may NOT use the pool, fitness floor, gym, or playground.
- Players and spectators are to use the pool locker room bathrooms only.
- Manager must report missing or incorrect game scores via email to: jcarper@ymcaoc.org
- Manager may only add players before the 6th game of the season. Registration and adjusted team rosters need to be turned in to the office 24 hours before the first game in which a new player will participate.
- Manager must ensure that any red-carded player(s); if they are removed from one league, that removal applies to all leagues. If a player receives a red card, they must leave the premises through the side gate and are not to enter the facility; this is for the safety of our members.
- Manager(s) are responsible to report ALL injuries sustained during play IMMEDIATELY to YMCA staff.
- **All players must be registered through the YMCA to play. If a team plays with an unregistered or ineligible player, the game(s) will be forfeited, and the team may be removed from the league without a refund. The YMCA has the authority to question, card, or remove any player on a team at any given time. Players MUST have proper photo identification at all times and may be asked to show ID at any time.**
- Abusive language or behavior towards teammates, referees, opponents, or anyone on the sidelines will **NOT** be tolerated. The player will be carded and may be removed from the game or league at the Sports Director's discretion.
- The YMCA reserves the right to ask a manager to step down at any time during a season.
