Arrival/Departure Time:

Teams cannot enter the building until after 4:00 p.m. Teams must depart as soon after the game as possible.



These expectations and Guidelines apply to ALL TEAMS' players, coaches, parents, spectators, officials, and staff.

All expectations from the Parent/Player Contract Signed at the beginning of the season apply to games. Poor sportsmanship will NOT be tolerated and is grounds for removal from the facility and/or the team being forfeited from the game.

Communication:

- Deaf School that uses American Sign Language.
- To communicate with our Deaf coaches, staff, or students--here are a few options:
 - use the Notes app on your phone, turn on the mic, your voice will transfer to text for the Deaf individual to read.
 - Paper and pen
 - Whiteboard to write your messages back and forth

Facility Policies:

- All games will be played in accordance with the sport specific rules set by the Jeffco League.
- Vending machines are available to use. Drinking fountains are available.
- Teams are expected to clean up their bench area at the completion of each game.
- Teams are also expected to have their spectators and fans clean up their area after each game.
- Teams, fans, and spectators are required to leave the building immediately at the end of each game.
- No food or drink is allowed in the gym. Only bottled water is permitted.
- Locker rooms are available to use. Players are not allowed to hang in the locker rooms.
- Players are not permitted to wander the halls and the rest of the building. The players and families are to stay in the gym during the entire game.
- Players need to be supervised by a coach or parent at all times when not participating in a game.

In-game Setup:

The clock operator and bookkeepers are allowed at the scorers' table.

Half-time:

Teams will remain near their bench area in the gym or field. Locker rooms in the gym or unisex restrooms outside of the gym are available for bathroom use. During flag football/soccer season, a portable restroom is available next to the playground by the field.

Post Game/Exit:

After each game, teams must leave the building right away. The gym will be cleared for cleaning.
