Player Code of Conduct

All players will abide by the officials' decision and rules set in play by the league administrator. A player ejected from the game will be suspended a minimum of two weeks from the complex which may include games in other divisions and games on other nights as well. If there is a second offense the player runs the risk of being suspended for the remainder of the season and will have to pay a \$50 fee to be reinstated.

If a player or manager is ejected from the game, that player or manager must leave the field and facility immediately.

No player, coach, spectator, or manager shall physically attack, act as an aggressor towards any person, player, spectator, Official, or City employee; and or act in any threatening or intimidating manner. PENALTY: Officials are required to immediately eject player(s) from further play and report such player(s) to the league supervisor. Failure to give a player's name will only use up game time as the game clock will not be stopped. Such player(s) shall remain suspended until his/her case has been reviewed. If captains do not provide the suspended players name they will have to serve the suspension.

All players, coaches, captain and spectators will abstain from the use of vulgarity, racial slur, verbal abuse, threats, or unsportsmanlike conduct while participating in any City of Westminster activity.

No player, coach, captain or spectator will be allowed to participate or remain in the facility if acting in an intoxicated manner or any manner which is deemed harmful to the game or its participants.

Smoking is not permitted within 15' of the front doors of the Sports Center facility.

The league officials have the authority to call the game at any time due to inappropriate behavior.

Elastic Power - Any and all situations not specifically covered in the rule book shall be acted upon by the Recreation Supervisor/Sports and all such action taken shall be permanent.

ALCOHOL / DRUGS

It is not permissible to bring alcohol/drugs in any form into any City of Westminster building or the surrounding parking lots.

Violation of this rule can result in the team forfeiting.

Players that are found to have brought in alcohol/drugs may be subjected to automatic ejection for the day/night and may face additional suspension.

Spectators that bring in alcohol/drugs will be asked to leave the facility for the day/night immediately. Anyone caught with outside alcohol/drugs may be subject to a citation from Westminster Police Department.
