### **INTRODUCTION**

Please review the enclosed rules and materials with your team. The Ankeny Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to make changes to this document as necessary during the course of the season. Managers will be notified of any changes.

### **LIABILITY STATEMENT**

The City of Ankeny, Parks and Recreation and its employees or appointed agents assume no responsibility for any personal injury or loss that any team member or spectator may incur as a result of our programs. Individuals are encouraged to have their own personal health/accident plans for any such injuries, which could occur. Players may be held responsible for unnecessary damage, which may occur as a result of misconduct in a facility.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- All players must be 18 years of age prior to the start of league play.
- The fee for participation by a non-resident is \$10 per person.
- All team and non-resident fees must be paid at the Parks and Recreation Office before participating in the league.

### **FACILITIES/EQUIPMENT**

It is imperative that all participants show respect and take care of Hawkeye Park, bags and boards.

#### Equipment Check Out:

- Home team must check out the bags before their scheduled match at the concession stand
- Participants must leave their driver's license with City Staff in order to check out the bags
- Bags must be returned following your match
- **Winning team must report the scores to concession stand staff (i.e. 5-0, 4-1, 3-2)**
- All unreported scores after the final week of the regular season will be considered a double forfeit.
- Failure to return the bags will result in a \$25 charge
- Board Numbers: Boards are number 1-10 going from west to east

### **GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME**

Be RESPECTFUL – teams sign up wanting to play and not wanting forfeits. Do your part and have enough players each week. More than one forfeit in a season or if the entire team no shows, without notifying the opposing manager and the Recreation Superintendent will result in immediate release from the league with no refund of fees.

**Weeknight Leagues:** You must notify the opposing team manager and Recreation Superintendent before 4:30 p.m. on the scheduled game day.

### **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES & SMOKING**

- **No alcohol is allowed to be brought onto or leave the premises.**

- Customer must be (21) twenty-one years of age and provide adequate photo identification to purchase beer.
- Purchaser can buy no more than two cans of beer at a time.
- Beer Sales are allowed:
  - a. Weekdays beginning at 5:30 p.m. and ending at the start of the last scheduled match.
  - b. Weekends beginning at 10:30 a.m. and ending at the start of the last scheduled match, or not later than 9:30 p.m.
- The City of Ankeny does not serve to intoxication, nor does it serve the intoxicated.
- We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone believed to be intoxicated.
- Hawkeye Park is a smoke free facility; if you desire to smoke it must be done out in the parking lot. Smoking is forbidden by the concession stand or sand volleyball courts.
- *First Warning* – Player or players will be asked to leave the complex
- *Second Warning* – Team will be disqualified from the league with no refund

#### ***INCLEMENT WEATHER***

- If there has been inclement weather, teams may call the “Weather Hotline” at 963-3575 after 4:30 p.m. or [www.teamsideline.com/ankeny](http://www.teamsideline.com/ankeny) to find out the status of their match.
- If matches have been cancelled for the evening by Parks and Recreation, matches may not be played that evening. Any matches played on these days will not be recorded.

#### ***TIEBREAKER***

- In the event of identical league records, head-to-head competition will be used to determine the winner. If the teams split the head-to-head games, the team with the largest margin of victory in the head to head games shall be declared the winner. **If a tie remains, the team with the most total games won will be declared the winner.**

# ANKENY BAGS LEAGUE RULES

## Rules

- Teammates must stand on opposite sides.
- Bags will be set approximately 27'/24' (comp/rec) apart.
- Each player will throw 4 bags per inning.
- Players may throw from either side of the board. You must throw from the same position at the beginning of each inning.
- Player's feet must remain behind the front of the board on the release of the bag.
- The team that scores will throw first; if it's a tie the preceding team will throw again.
- Teams will play a total of 5 games
- TIEBREAKER – In the event of identical league records, head-to-head competition will be used to determine the winner. If a tie remains, the team with the most total games won will be declared the winner.
- No Baggos (bag cannot hit the ground first and roll onto the board)
- Time Limit – You have 45 minutes for each match. If the time is up, the team leading at that point will be the winner of that game.
- Teams may use a substitute partner in the event one is unable to attend up through the 6<sup>th</sup> game. Using a substitute past this time must be approved by the opponent or the game will be a disqualification.
- Subs may not be from a team already participating in the league night.
- Subs may not be used for multiple teams in the same league night.

## Scoring

- Hole-Ins = 3 points
- On-the-Board = 1 point
- In cancellation scoring, bags in-the-hole and on-the-board cancel each other out.
- First team to 21 points is the winner; you may exceed
- NO PROFANITY.
