REGISTRATIONS WILL BE DONE ONLINE

- **THERE will be a link on our website to follow for registration.**
- **Registration Begins February 27th at 12:01am and will be on a first come first serve basis.**

PLAYER REGISTRATION REQUIRED FOR ALL TEAMS:

- All schedules and receipts will be emailed to managers and will be available on the MPRB website. Schedules will be available at a minimum two weeks before the season starts.
- Roster form **must be completed online** and is due before your first scheduled game.
- Teams not properly registered by respective deadline date **FORFEIT** all consideration for league **championships and tournaments**. Managers are responsible for registering all players by the deadline date.
- Teams may register up to 20 players.

ENTRY FEE & REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

- **REGISTRATION WILL BE ONLINE, THERE NO LONGER IS A PRIORITY LIST--REGISTRATION BEGINS FEBRUARY 27th at 12:01AM FOR ALL TEAMS**
- **There will be a link on our website to follow for registration**
- **Sponsor checks-You may bring a sponsor check into MPRB Headquarters in place of online registration. Please note that we will not be able to hold a spot for you until we receive payment. In order to hold a spot you will need register for a league using your credit card. If you then bring a sponsor check to the MPRB we will refund your credit card and apply the sponsor check to your account.**
- **Season**
 - The season will begin the week of April 28th and run through the week of July 29. (12 games scheduled, 10 games guaranteed *(not counting forfeits)*)
 - We will offer Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday League's, no games scheduled on Holidays.

INTOXICATING BEVERAGES OR BEER PROHIBITED:

- The **park police will monitor fields** during games and will **issue tickets** for anyone drinking intoxicating beverages or beer at ball games / fields.
- Umpires are instructed not to umpire where these conditions exist.
- Drinking of intoxicating beverages or beer during a game by a participating player shall result in the immediate removal of that player from the game and/or team manager.
- It is requested that teams playing the LATE games at the lighted facilities leave the area in a reasonable time upon completion of their game.
- Consumption of beverages and other post-game activities must be moved to other facilities more adequately equipped to handle such large gatherings. The Park Police will monitor the parking areas and will take corrective action of violations to assist in relieving the congestion. Your cooperation is essential.

PARKING:

- All Minneapolis Park and Recreation or City of Minneapolis pay lots, meters and/or any other parking fees are the sole responsibility of the user. Being a participant in an MPRB athletic league does not guarantee free parking. The MPRB athletic department is providing the service of athletic league play only.

Gender Assignment for Sports Leagues

1. MPRB recognizes that gender identity and expression are more complex than sex assignment. Because the MPRB values all gender identities and expressions, we are developing a comprehensive gender inclusion action plan to support everyone in participating in MPRB programs and activities.

3. MPRB Leagues
 - a. MPRB Open Leagues: Sports leagues without gender restrictions for play and field/court position.
 - b. MPRB Co-Ed & Women's Leagues: Players must select one of two options (female/male) to meet current league rules and requirements. If your gender identity does not match your sex assignment, please contact the league director prior to the start of the season to accommodate these requirements.

Photography Waiver:

The MPRB staff and photographers occasionally take photographs and/or video of park activities and services (classes, programs, events, facility use, sports/athletic games, etc.) to be used for increasing awareness and use of the park system. Participation in MPRB league sports grants permission to the MPRB and anyone authorized by the MPRB to use and reproduce any and all photographic images and/or video that you have taken of participants and players for any purpose whatsoever (including, but not limited to, promotional materials and videos, brochures, publications, social media, MPRB website, City of Minneapolis cable channel, news releases, advertising or display) without further compensation to me.

- If an individual wishes to not be photographed, they may simply let the photographer know if one is present.
