2024 Summer & Fall Adult Tennis Information

- Summer Registration begins Tuesday, April 23rd at 12:01am.
- Fall Registration beings Tuesday, June 18th at 12:01am.

- Summer Tennis in your Park (TIYP) Lesson Fees: \$135.00 for 9 weeks.
- Park vs. Park Fees: \$35.00 for 6 weeks of play w/ t-shirt
- Fall Tennis in your Park (TIYP) Lesson Fees: \$80.00 for 5 weeks.
- Dates of Play:
 - o Summer TIYP Dates of Play: 6/1/2024 to 8/8/2024 (Weather Dates: 8/10-8/15)
 - o Park vs. Park Play Dates: 7/9/24 to 8/13/24 (Weather Date: 8/20/24)
 - Fall TIYP Dates of Play: 8/17/24 to 9/23/24 (Weather Dates: 9/24/24 9/30/24)
- **Participants**: Must be at least 18 yrs. old. Participants are required to bring their own tennis racquet unless otherwise noted. Please dress appropriately for the weather, wear proper footwear and bring water.
- Instructors: All classes taught by USTA trained instructor

Levels of Play

- o Tennis students are encouraged to take multiple lessons to advance from Beginner to Intermediate.
- o **Beginner -** Classes are for those who have little or no tennis experience. Learn the basic strokes and begin to rally. All participants will receive a new tennis racquet.
- o **Advanced Beginner** Classes are for those who know the basic strokes and are working further on ball tracking, movement and consistency. Players are ready for introductory social match play.
- o **Intermediate** Classes are for those continuing to develop their stroke consistency and accuracy while learning net play, court coverage and match strategy. Players are ready for formal, organized play.
- Drill and Play Fun, Fitness and Friends is the name of the game! Join us on court for group drills and match play.
 This class is for players who have tennis experience and know basic strokes and game scoring. Players will play a mix of organized hitting with multiple players and match play each week.

All participants must read the information before registering. All registrations are final, no refunds unless due to medical/illness or program cancellation. Participants waive, release, & discharge any & all claims for damages for personal injury, death, or property damage which may have, or which may hereafter accrue to players, as a result of participation from this activity.
