BASEBALL & SOFTBALL Common Misconceptions + (answers):



- 1. Tie goes to the runner. NO (no such thing as a tie) (either out of safe)
- 2. If the ball hits the plate it is a foul ball. NO (plate is in fair territory)
- 3. Hands are part of the bat. NO (hands are not wood or aluminum)
- Batter-Runner turns left after overrunning first base, in jeopardy.
 NO (must make an attempt to go toward second)
- 5. Out if you carry the bat while running. NO (only if it interferes)
- 6. Runner must slide. NO (but must avoid fielder with the ball)
- Batter Runner may over run first on a walk. TRUE in SB.
 False in BB (over run and the runner is in jeopardy to being tagged out)
- 8. Ball four (pitch) out of play. Batter gets 2 bases. NO (only one, first base)
- 9. Pitch hits batter in strike zone or after swing. HBP. NO (dead ball, strike)
- 10. Runner must tag up after <u>catch</u>. YES & NO (may tag and legally leave after the ball is first touched) (don't have to wait for the ball to be legally caught)
- 11. Runner is out if running out of the baseline. (Only if attempting to avoid the tag). (Runner makes own baseline until the fielder has the ball)
- 12. Batted ball hits batter in fair territory in the box. Out. NO (foul ball)
- 13. Batted ball hits runner off the base, the runner is always out. NO (not if the ball passes a fielder and no other fielder has a chance to; make an OUT in SB or make a PLAY in BB).
- 14. Batter Runner is out when running outside the 3 foot lane to first. YES/NO (Only OUT if BR interferes with a fielder taking the throw at first base)
- 15. Illegal pitch hits batter, runners don't advance unless forced. SB TRUE Unless (Coach gets to choose. Play or penalty. HBP or illegal pitch).
 BB FALSE (an illegal pitch is a BALK and a dead ball/no pitch. All runners advance one base whether forced or not).
- 16. Overthrow (1 plus 1) base going to plus 1. NO (award all runners 2 bases from where the runners were at the release of the throw)
- 17. Catch. He had the ball long enough. NO (time not a factor, must have control of the ball in glove or hand and the release was voluntary)
- 18. Umpire must make the call quick! NO (wait until the play is over)
- 19. Coaches know all the rules. NO (no one knows ALL the rules)
- Umpires are expected to be perfect at the start of each game and get better with each call. YES (impossible yet expected)
