SUMMER ADULT VOLLEYBALL SAND LEAGUES 2022 LEAGUE INFORMATION

TUESDAY - SAND COED 4s A THURSDAY - SAND COED 4s B

LEAGUE OVERVIEW

- A & B divisions will be available.
- League play begins the week of June 21.
- 12 teams per league
- 8 weeks of league play games
- 1 week of single elimination playoffs.
- Games will be played rain or shine. Severe weather cancelations will be at the discretion of THPRD program staff.
- Match nights: A league primarily on Tuesdays. B league will primarily be on Thursdays. Teams must be willing to play on other nights as scheduled.
- Rosters must list a minimum of 4 players and maximum of 8 players.
- Players must be 18 years of age or older and finished with high school.
- Location: Sand volleyball courts at Cedar Hills Park.
- If a team forfeits two matches, they will be dropped from the league and forfeit all fees paid.
- Roster Additions any roster changes must be made by the approval of league administrator.

SUBS:

- At least 3 team members must be present at the beginning of a match for it to count. *(the league director has discretion to change this due to mitigating circumstances)*
- Subs can be picked up from off team within the same division
- Subs can be used from outside the league.
- Please use players that are close to the same level as the player you are subbing for.
- During playoffs, only rostered players are eligible to play. Exceptional substitute may be requested prior to the playoffs and will need to be approved by Program Coordinator.

LEAGUE FEES - Online and walk-in to the Athletic Center registration opens on May **4**, 2022 at 12p.m. Payment must be made when registering the team.

1. League fees: Coed 4 - \$410 per team

Information is available online at <u>www.thprd.org</u>. Out of district players do not need to pay the summer assessment fee as it is included in the league fee.



GHOST CARDS

1. No ghost cards are available.

ROSTERS

- 1. **ALL ROSTERS** must be completed online or using the attached team roster form (listing out-of-district players first). Incomplete rosters will not be accepted.
- Rosters: Doubles (RC2s): minimum of 2 players and maximum of 4 players.
 Quads: (Coed4s, RC4s and W4s): minimum 4 players and a maximum of 8 players.
- 3. A player may be registered on only ONE Tualatin Hills team per league.
- 4. Players must be at least 18 years of age or finished with high school.
- 5. All in-district and out-of-district players must have a valid THPRD Residency Card. For more information on obtaining a card please call the Athletic Center front desk at (503) 629-6330.
- 6. Managers must list all player's THPRD residency card NUMBER on the roster. If a player does not have a THPRD residency card they may not be added to the roster.
- 7. All rosters will be checked for accuracy at the beginning of the season.

GENERAL TEAM CLASSIFICATIONS

Teams are to classify themselves based on their skill level and primary day of play. Skill levels are defined as:

A – Competitive: Teams consistently know where to be on the court when plays are developing and where to be when the opponent is hitting. Teams usually play a 6-2, 5-1 or a 4-2.

B – **Competitive Recreation:** Teams understand the concepts of team defense and positioning. Teams know how to bump, set, and spike but are not consistent at performing these skills at a high level.

C - **Recreational:** Teams understand the concepts of team defense and positioning. Teams know how to bump, set, and spike but are not consistent at performing these skills at a high level. Teams just want to play and have fun.

Teams are asked to place themselves in a division with teams of similar caliber.

Teams will not be moved into another division unless there is unanimous consent from all other teams in the current division.

Final decision will be made by the Tualatin Hills Sports Staff.

Payment will need to be made at the time of registration. The payment time stamp on the invoice will determine which teams will get accepted into the league

You will complete all the steps to register your team and invite players to sign up with your team.

You will be inviting players to agree to play on your team. The system will automatically send them an email with an invitation number. Players will need to go to <u>http://teamregistration.thprd.org/index.cfm/main/playerlogin</u> and logon. Once in they will need to cut and paste the invite number in. For the instructions click on the <u>User Guide</u> (PDF) under the login.

Each player needs to be registered with THPRD. Players that have their THPRD ID they can register online at <u>https://www.thprd.org/portal/</u>. If someone does not have their THPRD ID they will need to apply for their Residency Card by visiting the nearest THPRD facility. **Out of District players do not have to pay the out-of-district assessment fee. Managers can submit their name on the roster form to add them to the team.**

<u>SHORT CUT</u>: If all of your players have **current THPRD ID** cards you can click on "Add THPRD Players" after you create your team. Enter the Last Name, First Name and THPRD ID number for each player. Once all players are entered go to the bottom and click on Add To Roster. Once successfully added to the roster you can click on Roster, then on Confirm to add to your team and complete your registration (don't forget to pay the league fee).

MATCH PLAY

2 Matches per night 40 minute time limit per match

Match = 2 games to 21; cap of 21 Switch sides every 7 points Ball spin will determine who has first choice. Score boards will be provided.

REFFING

All teams will be assigned an equitable amount of reffing duties throughout the season. At least one team member from the reffing team must be available for the start of an assigned match.

All calls will be at the discretion of the reffing team.

MATCH TIMES:

6:00p-9:10p All matches will be timed by on-site THPRD staff If a team is not on the court at the start time of their match, their opponent will be awarded 1 point per minute.



TIME OUTS:

Each team is allowed one 30 second timeout per set. No timeouts during the last 5 minutes of play time. A timeout not used will not be carried over to the next game. THPRD COED BEACH VOLLEYBALL RULES

- NO setting on a serve
- Block **DOES COUNT** as a touch
- Double contact is only ok on hard driven balls.
- NO directional set over (shoulders must be squared when setting forward or behind)
- NO open hand tipping
- Must rotate servers
- A net is a net (women hair is OK)
- One guy & one girl per team
- Let serves are OK
- Open Hand play:
- You can open hand received a hard-hit ball during game play.
- A hard hit ball off a block can be handled with open hands if the official determines that there is not enough time for the defender to change.
- Interference with the opponents' ability to make a fair play is not allowed
- Incidental contact between opponents does not constitute interference (bump knee, step briefly on toes, etc.)
- Interference can occur without physical contact (fallen player under net prevents defender from covering short)
- Pursuit is legal in Coed Sand Volleyball as long as the player stays within the area of play and does not go into another court.
- The area of play is defined as the area surrounding the net that the teams are playing.
- A player may pursue under the net, even through your opponents' court.
- Opponents may not interfere with legal pursuit.
- Hand Setting:
- Hand setting calls will be looser in the Coed B division. General rule will be "athletic attempt."
- No carrying

PLAYOFFS

All teams in each division will make the playoffs.

No subbing from off teams.

Playoffs will be single elimination.

There will be no point cap for playoff games.

1st place teams of the playoffs will be awarded.



EQUIPMENT

Game volleyballs will be provided.

Teams are allowed to play with other beach volleyballs. If there is any discrepancy, then teams will use the volleyballs provided by THPRD.

OTHER

Insurance - Insurance will not supplied by THPRD.
