Orting Recreation Program Terms & Conditions:

Payment Policy: The City of Orting offers families' payment options via the following methods: Cash, check, credit, or debit in office, or online registration. Registration in office with debit cards will be charged a \$1.00 fee, and credit cards a \$2.00 fee. Please make all checks payable to the City of Orting. A \$40.00 service fee is incurred for all checks returned NSF (non-sufficient funds).

Registration is on a first come, first served basis. Pre-Registration and payment of fees in advance is required for all programs. Refunds will be issued at the rate of 100% before the class begins, or 50% if withdrawn during the first week of class. There are no refunds issued after the first week of class has been completed. All refund requests must be submitted in writing or emailed to recreation@cityoforting.org. No refunds issued for missed classes, camps, or clinics. If the class is full when we receive your registration form, we will let you know and mail you a refund to the listed address. Classes are subject to cancellation if minimum is not met. The City of Orting reserves the right to cancel classes due to insufficient registration or causes beyond its control. If class or activity is cancelled before it commences, a full refund will be issued.

****If the State of Washington issues a mask mandate that applies to any participant in the class, the entire class will be required to wear a mask to participate. If you wish to withdraw due to a mask mandate for the class, no refunds will be given.****

Participant safety, as well as the safety of our volunteers and staff is the utmost importance to us. Please carefully review the following:

- I acknowledge that I (and/or my child) will be required to comply with all COVID-19 safety requirements applicable to this program issued by a federal, state or local official.
- **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF COVID-19 EXPOSURE RISK:** I acknowledge that participation in this City of Orting program may result in exposure to COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) and other contagious diseases and that the risk of exposure cannot be entirely eliminated. I accept that participation in this program may expose me, my children or family members to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. I understand that the program may institute reasonable screening measures such as self-checks and temperature checks to reduce the risk of exposure to COVID-19 and other communicable diseases and agree to abide by those procedures. I further understand that any program participant may be excluded from the program at the sole discretion of City staff, if they exhibit an elevated temperature, other signs of obvious illness, or repeatedly fail to follow social distancing rules. I will explain these rules to my child, as requested. I understand that the program operations may be closed or limited on short notice, based on the guidance of state and local health authorities.
- The City of Orting DOES NOT provide medical or accidental insurance coverage – the participant is responsible. If the participant is a minor, the guardian is responsible. I do hereby waive any and all claims of legal actions, financial or otherwise, against the City of Orting, its employees, officers, agents, hired or contracted instructors and their employees or agents, and give

permission for any of the above to seek medical attention if I am not able to be contacted immediately.

- All participants, or if the participant is a minor, the guardian, must read and agree to the Concussion Information Sheet.
- League registrations will receive email and/or phone notification from the coach regarding practices. All missed games will be made up at a later date, weather permitting.
- Hold Harmless Clause: I/We assume all risks and hazards incidental to such participation and do hereby agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Orting, its officers, employees, and agents, for any claims of any kind arising out of my participation in this activity, including but not limited to any injury or death to myself or my minor child.
- I am over the age of eighteen, I have signed this release voluntarily and with full understanding of the terms herein, and do so under penalty of perjury under laws of the State of Washington.

Inclement Weather Policy:

If the Orting School District is closed or on a two (2) hour delay, all classes, events, or activities will be cancelled. For weekend programming, a decision will be made by 7am regarding programming for that day. The announcement will be made via city website, Parks and Recreation Facebook page, e-mail blast and text messages to participants. If a program, class, event, or activity is cancelled, every effort will be made to reschedule a make-up at a later date.

Media Release:

I grant the City of Orting full permission to use any photographs, video recordings, motion pictures, audio recordings, or any other record of this program for promotional purposes and documentary purposes. This document shall serve as a release for myself, my child/ward and our heirs, estate successors, and all members of our family.

Instructor Policy:

City of Orting recreation programs are instructor-led programs. In the event the instructor is unavailable to complete a program, the City will attempt to find an alternate instructor. If an alternate instructor is not available to complete the program, the City will issue prorated refunds to participants for the remaining portion(s) of that program.

Age Policy:

For all Orting Recreation Sports, Dance & Activity programs, participants must turn the required age for the program by the date that the program begins. This date will vary depending on the program and time of year. For example, if the minimum age required is (3) three, the participant must have their third birthday before the date that the program begins.

Regarding requests for a player to “play-up” an age bracket, the parent must first register the child for their current age bracket, then request that the player “play-up” an age bracket. After registration closes, if space is available, the player will be placed in the older age bracket. “Play-up” requests are NOT guaranteed.
